Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on Wednesday, 26 June 2019

RACE 1: WOLF BLASS WINES / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 2138 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

LIPPSY SHUFFLE (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly. Weakened from approaching the 400 metres. Rider reported that in his opinion the gelding did not handle the step up in distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PREDICATED (C. Jones) - hung out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WHEN STARS ALIGN (B. Vorster) – fractious prior to the barriers opening. Awkward and slow to begin losing three or four lengths. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Prior to correct weight being declared B. Vorster made a submission to the Stewards that the gelding be declared a non-runner as in his opinion it was denied a fair start due to the barrier attendant still having hold of the horse after it was fractious and when the barriers were released. After considering the evidence, on viewing the vision and acting on their own observations Stewards declared WHEN STARS ALIGN a non-runner under AR204(1)(c).

MATAS (S. Fawke) - in the vicinity of the 1200 metres improved around the field to settle in the lead.

TAKE IT UP A GIA (J. Potter) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.



RACE 1: WOLF BLASS WINES / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 2138 metres (cont'd)

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow B. Vorster to make a submission to the Stewards that WHEN STARS ALIGN be declared a non-runner as in his opinion it was denied a fair start due to the barrier attendant still having hold of the horse after it was fractious and when the barrier were released. After considering the evidence, on viewing the vision and acting on their own observations Stewards declared WHEN STARS ALIGN a non-runner under AR204(1)(c).

RACE 2: AUSBIA ELECTRICAL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1526 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

CHASE THE THRILLS (J. Maund) - weakened from approaching the 400 metres.

I WON'T DO THAT (D. Tourneur) - difficult to load. Trainer, Mr S. Burford, was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners. Held up for clear running for a short distance approaching the 400 metres. Hung in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LORD GILBERT (P. Gatt) - on pulling up rider was dislodged. LORD GILBERT ran freely for a short distance before being recaptured. P. Gatt was examined by the First Care Medical personal and was passed fit to fulfil his remaining engagements.

COVER GIRL (A. Jordsjo) - jumped away awkwardly. Held up for a short distance approaching the 400 metres.

RYZLINK (C. Lions) - trainer, Mr J. Macmillan, advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that he would instruct his rider to attempt to gain cover in today's event. Settled behind the leader. Inside the 1300 metres, when over-racing, was obliged to be restrained when awkwardly placed on the heels of BRAKEFOOT BLING.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow P. Gatt to be examined by the First Care Medical staff and to return to weigh in.

RACE 3: THETERRACEFUNCTIONCENTRE.COM / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

DR CHOCCY (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow into stride. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DREAMLAND (S. Price) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced since April 2018 and was passed fit to start.

VON LA VOLTA (J. Holder) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. Hung in severely under pressure in the straight proving difficult to ride out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MEADOWS KID (J. Potter) – raced keenly and greenly in the early and middle stages of the event and in the vicinity of the 800 metres was obliged to be restrained when awkwardly placed on the heels of COOGEE DANCER, which was over-racing and racing greenly. As a result, SHINING BRIGHTLY, which was following, was inconvenienced. In the vicinity of the 600 metres was tightened between DREAMLAND, which rolled in, and DR CHOCCY, which rolled out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

COOGEE DANCER (J. Maund) – over-raced throughout the event and got its head up on a number of occasions when being restrained in the early stages. Raced greenly throughout the event.

SWIFTY (K. Cowan) - jumped away awkwardly.

SHINING BRIGHTLY (P. Gatt) - in the vicinity of the 800 metres was inconvenienced when MEADOWS KID, which was racing keenly and greenly, was restrained away from heels.

RACE 4: ADELAIDE PLAINS BLOODSTOCK BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1738 metres

KING RED (T. Pannell) - dipped shortly after the entrance to the straight.

BEHAVE (S. Logan) – performed below expectations. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

COBBERS MATE (S. Fawke) - in the vicinity of the 1300 metres was restrained to obtain cover and got its head up.

HARLEM LOVE (J. Potter) - on jumping away was taken in by WINGARD onto PLAYFUL HOST.

PLAYFUL HOST (J. Chau) - on jumping away lost its position when tightened onto ZAALADD as HARLEM LOVE was taken in.

WINGARD (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto HARLEM LOVE.

RACE 5: PROPER CLEAN BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

GOOD LUCK CHUCK (R. Clark) - jumped away awkwardly.

EQUUS D'ORO (J. Chau) - in the vicinity of the 900 metres rolled in onto ARDIZZONE, which was tightened.

RAHEEBA (T. Voorham) – in the vicinity of the 900 metres was obliged to be steadied and lost its position as ANAMNESIS, which was racing keenly, rolled out and ATOMIC LOKADE was taken in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SIR JOHNSON (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

ARDIZZONE (L. Neindorf) - jumped away awkwardly. Approaching the 900 metres improved into a tight run to the inside of EQUUS D'ORO. Shortly afterwards contacted ATOMIC LOKADE, and as a result had its hindquarters turned and was then unable to relieve the pressure on ATOMIC LOKADE due to the positioning of EQUUS D'ORO, and as a result E. Boyd was obliged to take hold of ATOMIC LOKADE, which lost its position. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ANAMNESIS (P. Gatt) - in the vicinity of the 900 metres when racing keenly became awkwardly placed on the heels of BIRDS IN HAND rolled out onto RAHEEBA, which was taken out and tightened onto ATOMIC LOKADE.

ATOMIC LOKADE (E. Boyd) - in the vicinity of the 900 metres was obliged to be taken hold of and lost its position when ARDIZZONE, which was taken in when racing tight to the inside of EQUSS D'ORO and RAHEEBA, which was taken out by ANAMNESIS, which was racing keenly and shifted out. In viewing the incident Stewards could not deem one rider at fault; however, advised all riders to exercise care in similar circumstances in future.

LA MAGIQUE (D. Tourneur) - bounded on jumping away. Approaching the 900 metres, when racing keenly, improved into a tight run between ATOMIC LOKADE and RAHEEBA, which was taken out slightly.

BIRDS IN HAND (S. Logan) - hung out under pressure in the straight.



RACE 6: TAB BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

FLORID (E. Boyd) - slow into stride. In the vicinity of the 900 metres contacted the running rail.

NASIFA (D. Tourneur) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

I AM GRACIE (J. Toeroek) - over-raced and got its head up on a number of occasions and in the vicinity of the 900 metres was tightened as SNOWBROOK shifted in.

SNOWBROOK (J. Maund) - in the vicinity of the 900 metres shifted in onto I AM GRACIE, which was over-racing. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground in future. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AMATIVE (P. Gatt) - fractious after being loaded and became cast. Underwent a veterinary examination and was ruled unfit to start. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew AMATIVE at 2.31 pm. Trainer, Mr K. Sweeney, was advised that the mare was now required to complete an Official Barrier Trial or Approval to Race jump-out to the Stewards' satisfaction prior to a future race. P. Gatt was examined by the First Care Medical personnel and ruled unfit to fulfil his remaining engagements. P. Gatt was advised that he was required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding again.

RACE 7: WOLF BLASS RASCALS CUP BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 2138 metres

SOARING HIGH (R. Clark) - rider reported that the gelding was disappointing in today's event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DANOULI (S. Fawke) - lost its near fore plate during the event.

RACE 8: COOPERS LAUNCH XPA BEER BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1526 metres

IMPULSE DIAVOLO (L. Neindorf) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had bled from both nostrils. Trainer, Mr S. Tootell, was advised that as this was the gelding's first bilateral bleed IMPULSE DIAVOLO would now be suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR79(4) and would be required to gallop 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future trial or race.

DIAMOND TYCOON (J. Chau) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres was hampered as GO STRAIGHTANDHARD was taken out by DOUBLE POCKETS.

UNSCOPEABLE (T. Voorham) - held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until in the vicinity of the 100 metres.

DOUBLE POCKETS (C. Jones) - inclined to hang out under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 200 metres rolled out taking GO STRAIGHTANDHARD out onto DIAMOND TYCOON, which was hampered. Rider reminded of her obligations when shifting ground and advised to take greater care in future.

GO STRAIGHTANDHARD (T. Pannell) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres was taken out by DOUBLE POCKETS onto DIAMOND TYCOON.

JOCKS GLEN (R. Clark) - held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until inside the 100 metres.



RACE 8: COOPERS LAUNCH XPA BEER BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1526 metres (cont'd)

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow J. Chau (DIAMOND TYCOON), placed third, co-trainer, Mr L. Macdonald, and part-owner, Mr G. Cox, to view the vision in the straight. After doing so J. Chau lodged an objection against GO STRAIGHTANDHARD (T. Pannell) being declared the second placegetter on the grounds of alleged interference in the vicinity of the 200 metres. After considering the evidence, on viewing the vision and acting on their own observations Stewards *dismissed* the objection.

RACE 9: GOLDIN FARMS BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

TOUCH (J. Chau) - in the vicinity of the 400 metres rider dropped his whip.

OH MO (D. Tourneur) - slow to begin. Hung in under pressure in the straight.

BOOMER BEACH (L. Neindorf) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Shortly after the entrance to the straight was disappointed when attempting a tight run between MARINA and CLASSY JOE, and was obliged to shift in to obtain clear ground. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MASIPAG (S. Price) - trainer, Mr R. Balfour, reported to Stewards after the event that he will recommend to owners that the mare be retired.

POWER GLEN (T. Pannell) - on arrival on course was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon as it had not raced since August 2017 and was passed fit to start.

OUTINTHESTREET (J. Toeroek) - shortly after the start bumped with EXALTED TRAVELLER, which shifted in.

CONCONI (C. Jones) - inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EXALTED TRAVELLER (S. Logan) - shortly after the start shifted in and bumped OUTINTHESTREET.

HILUMIERE (K. Bishop) - contacted a perimeter fence prior to exiting the mounting yard. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to start. Rider was questioned regarding the tactics adopted in today's event. She explained that she had no firm instructions; however, she was surprised that she found herself leading comfortably. She further explained that after beginning well and the early formation of the field she had found herself in the lead. She added that the mare was racing first up in today's event. Trainer, Mr G. Lesnikowski, confirmed that there were no firm instructions; however, he was surprised to see the mare in the lead.

GENERAL:

<u>PORT AUGUSTA - SUNDAY, 23 JUNE 2019</u> <u>RACE 5: BOLLARDS LAGOON PASTORAL COMPANY BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1600 metres</u>

REGAL EAGLE - Stewards concluded an adjourned inquiry at the TRSA Offices on Monday, 24 June 2019 to allow J. Chau to have his master present. Laid in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 50 meters shifted in when insufficiently clear of IRISH MAMBO, which was obliged to be taken hold of and as a result was taken in on WITCH KID. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Wednesday, 26 June 2019 and to conclude midnight Wednesday, 3 July 2019, a period of three meeting.
