

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 28 December 2019

RACE 1: FURPHY TWO-YEAR-OLD PLATE - 1050 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

UNSTOPPABELLE (H. Coffey) - underwent a veterinary examination after arrival on course as the filly had fell over in its race-day stall. Found to be lame in the near hind leg and ruled unfit to start. Acting on this advice UNSTOPPABELLE was declared a late scratching by order of Stewards on veterinary advice at 12.15 pm.

EXALTED JOY (J. Holder) - lost its near fore plate en route to the barriers. Replated on arrival at the barriers, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to race. Inside the 1000 metres rolled out at the same time as JYOTI, which raced a little greenly, rolled in resulting in EXALTED JOY being momentarily inconvenienced. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JYOTI (B. Vorster) - raced greenly during the event and inside the 1000 metres rolled in slightly and inconvenienced EXALTED JOY, which rolled out.

ANOTHER AWARD (J. Chau) - raced greenly in the straight and was inclined to lay in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: TAB ADELAIDE CUP, MARCH 9 2020 HANDICAP - 1538 metres

THE PUGILIST (B. Vorster) - contacted at the start.

SODALITE (T. Pannell) - awkward to begin. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

ROBE BAY (T. Voorham) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Near the 600 metres rolled out, became awkward inside the heels of SODALITE, clipped that horse's heels and stumbled.

JACK'S A CRACKER (S. Logan) - began awkwardly, shifted out and contacted THE PUGILIST. Laid out under pressure in the straight.



RACE 3: FLEURIEU MILK COMPANY HANDICAP - 1600 metres

BRAMFIELD (T. Pannell) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RAGING QUEEN (T. Voorham) - laid in under pressure over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: AAMI HANDICAP - 1050 metres

BRONSKI GIRL (H. Coffey) - near the 700 metres was brushed by EFFORTKAT, which shifted out slightly and thereafter had difficulty obtaining clear running from approaching the 200 metres until inside the 100 metres.

AUTUMN SPLENDOUR (K. Crowther) - slow into stride. Laid in throughout the event placing its rider at a disadvantage in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MAGIC DEE (J. Potter) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

EFFORTKAT (J. Holder) - near the 700 metres shifted out momentarily and brushed BRONSKI GIRL.

RACE 5: TAB HANDICAP - 1200 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately five minutes owing to REGALO DI GAETANO having the be replated in the mounting yard.

OBERLAND (T. Voorham) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BENZ (K. Crowther) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PROUD WOLF (J. Chau) - over-raced in the early stages of the event. Obliged to race wide without cover for some distance in the early stages.

OAMARU OWL (J. Maund) - inclined to lay out over the concluding stages.

STREET LIFE (T. Pannell) - shifted out slightly shortly after the entrance to the straight.

KABINI (D. Tourneur) - shifted out and away from BENZ at the start and inconvenienced REGALO DI GAETANO, which was awkward to begin. Rolled in shortly after the entrance to the straight.

REGALO DI GAETANO (J. Toeroek) - spread its near hind plate in the mounting yard and had to be replated by the Farrier. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was passed fit to race. Awkward to begin and shortly thereafter was inconvenienced by KABINI, which shifted out. Inclined to lay in, in the straight.

TABLE OF WISDOM (B. Vorster) - inside the 300 metres when racing between KABINI, which rolled in and STREET LIFE, which shifted out to improve, was momentarily inconvenienced when giving ground.

RACE 6: SCHWEPPES HANDICAP - 1200 metres

MAGNUS KNIGHT (S. Price) - Stewards granted permission for MAGNUS KNIGHT to race equipped in blinkers only and no winkers, following a submission by Trainer Mr R. Balfour that the winkers were added as gear in error and that blinkers was the only gear intended to be added for the horse to race with.



RACE 6: SCHWEPPES HANDICAP - 1200 metres (cont'd)

WYLIE OL' COYOTE (T. Voorham) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FANCY RUMBLE (T. Pannell) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Inclined to lay in, in the early part of the straight.

FAST FEVER (NZ) (H. Coffey) - rider explained that the gelding raced flat and failed to finish the race off in the manner expected and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

COUNTER DRIVE (J. Chau) - shifted ground slightly in the early part of the straight.

LOVE MAGIC (P. Gatt) - had difficulty obtaining clear running from inside the 300 metres until near the 100 metres when racing in restricted room between FANCY RUMBLE, which was inclined to lay in and COUNTER DRIVE, which was inclined to shift ground slightly in the early part of the straight.

RACE 7: SCHWEPPES SOUTHERN SPEED SERIES FINAL (BENCHMARK 75 HANDICAP) - 2046 metres

EPERDUMENT (C. Parish) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STAR STATUS (J. Holder) - hung in throughout in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SET TO CRUISE (T. Pannell) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BLUE BEAR (H. Coffey) - was held up for clear running from inside the 500 metres until near the 300 metres and thereafter laid out over the concluding stages of the event.

TATALINA (NZ) (B. Vorster) - rider explained he would have preferred to have settled a little more forward than he was able to. He added that after settling back the mare travelled comfortably however, when improving his position from near the 600 metres, the field fanned wide and as a consequence he was obliged to race wide into the straight but notwithstanding, the mare finished the race off very well. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HASTA LA FIORENTE (T. Voorham) – over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event and was held up for clear running from near the 400 metres until near the 300 metres.

DR DEPENDABLE (J. Chau) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

FLORIANO (J. Toeroek) - Stewards permitted J. Toeroek to ride the filly 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.5kg. Inclined to lay in, in the straight.

RACE 8: WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS HANDICAP - 1600 metres

SORNJA (T. Voorham) - slow to begin. Threw its head up shortly after the start and then raced keenly for some distance thereafter. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ALLUSION (B. Vorster) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HAHNDORF (J. Chau) - laid in, in the straight.
