RACE 1: JONES ELECTRICAL MAIDEN/CLASS ONE PLATE - 1750 metres

KAAPOW (S. Fawke) - laid out under pressure over the concluding 150 metres. Approaching the 100 metres had to be steadied momentarily off the heels of BURGUNDEE MISS.

THE FOUR CEES (J. Potter) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

BURGUNDEE MISS (T. Voorham) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight and approaching the 100 metres shifted in slightly onto KAAPOW.

LILAC WINE (S. Logan) - in the vicinity of the 300 metres and again near the 200 metres, shifted out slightly and brushed RAYLEIGH.

RAYLEIGH (J. Chau) - in the vicinity of the 300 metres and again near the 200 metres, shifted in slightly and brushed LILAC WINE.

GRAND BARBA (E. Boyd) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider reported the gelding was inclined to lay in throughout the event and commenced to weaken of its own accord, in the vicinity of the 500 metres. Trainer Mr D. Carrison advised a warned had been placed on the gelding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: RSM / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE- 1210 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately five minutes.

BURNING HARD (B. Sweeney) - laid in throughout the event making contact with the running rail on a number of occasions.

STREETS AFTER DARK (K. Bishop) - Trainer Mr T. Montgomerie was advised a warned had been placed on the gelding in relation to it proving difficult to load. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

ULTIMATE VIEW (J. Chau) - Trainer Mr J. Dunn was advised a warned had been placed on the gelding in relation to it proving difficult to load.

RACE 2: RSM / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE- 1210 metres (Cont'd)

PRINCE ZACHERY (E. Boyd) - slow to begin.

ALL THINGS NICE (L. Neindorf) - Trainer Mr A. Jarvis advised a warned had been placed on the mare in relation to it proving difficult to load.

IMBOSSIBLE (J. Potter) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

LADANES (T. Voorham) - Trainer Mr R. King was advised a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to it proving difficult to load.

LOVE ME HARDER (A. Jordsjo) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

QUICKER THAN SLICK (M. Collett) - Trainer Mr K. Healy was advised a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to it proving difficult to load.

RACE 3: PORT LINCOLN REAL ESTATE / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

WOTUWANT (T. Pannell) - laid out under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted out onto BLUE GRANITE. Rider reminded of his obligations.

BLUE GRANITE (J. Potter) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. In the vicinity of the 100 metres had to be steadied when tightened between WOTUWANT, which shifted out and THE MASTER, which shifted in slightly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE MASTER (L. Neindorf) - shifted in on jumping away onto RASHYATHERE. Raced wide without cover throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted in slightly onto BLUE GRANITE.

HE'S ABEL (S. Logan) - jumped away awkwardly.

RASHYATHERE (J. Chau) - inconvenienced on jumping away when tightened by THE MASTER. Hung in, in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TIME GENTLEMAN (E. Boyd) - rider reported the gelding was inclined to lay out in the straight.

RACE 4: HANKINS ELECTRICAL BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

AHIGA (J. Chau) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight.

CALL ME HERBIE (A. Jordsjo) - shifted out in the vicinity of the 200 metres onto SWING IT SISTER.

SWING IT SISTER (E. Annells) - approaching the 200 metres had to momentarily steady when CALL ME HERBIE shifted out. Near the 100 metres was forced to race in restricted room and was untested to line when tightened onto CALL ME HERBIE by BUNDLE O'DIAMONDS, which shifted out.

CHUCKLES (J. Potter) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

BUNDLE O' DIAMONDS (K. Bishop) - laid out under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 100 metres shifted out onto SWING IT SISTER.

RACE 5: LINCOLN ESTATE WINES BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1390 metres

FEARLESS AL (J. Chau) - jumped away awkwardly. Held up from the vicinity of the 500 metres until the entrance to the straight. Shifted in under riding in the vicinity of the 100 metres onto KEEP DIGGING. Rider reprimanded.

IRISH MAMBO (S. Logan) -a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TYCOON FLUTTER (NZ) (A. Jordsjo) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

KEEP DIGGING (K. Bishop) - hampered in the vicinity of the 100 metres when taken in by FEARLESS AL.

SPIRITOS (M. Collett) - raced in restricted room for a short distance entering the straight when awkwardly placed between TYCOON FLUTTER (NZ) and STONECAST.

HARDASHIAN (T. Voorham) - hung in, in the straight.

RACE 6: KYM CLARKE CONSTRUCTIONS CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1000 metres

DOCTOR DOOLITTLE (R. Hurdle) - shifted in, in the vicinity of the 150 metres onto CHINESIS. Rider severely reprimanded.

CHINESIS (J. Chau) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 150 metres was forced to take hold when tightened between DOCTOR DOOLITTLE, which shifted in and AVORA SUN, which had been taken out by LA PETITE ROUSSE. Approaching the finish had to be steadied when AVORA SUN shifted out.

LA PETITE ROUSSE (T. Voorham) - laid out under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 150 metres shifted out onto AVORA SUN, which was taken wider onto CHINESIS. Rider severely reprimanded.

STAR PARFAIT (K. Bishop) - over-raced in the middle stages of the event.

AVORA SUN (E. Boyd) - laid out under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 150 metres was taken out by LA PETITE ROUSSE onto CHINESIS and was unable to improve for a number of strides. Approaching the finish shifted out under riding onto CHINESIS. Rider reprimanded.

WINE DANCE (S. Logan) - reared on jumping away and as a result missed the start by several lengths.

RACE 7: MITAVITE - LEADERS IN EQUINE NUTRITION BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1960 metres

ABBI FEDE (B. Sweeney) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Had difficulty obtaining clear ground from the vicinity of the 600 metres until inside the 400 metres.

EMOJI (K. Bishop) - jumped away awkwardly.

DANCE OF HEROES (GB) (G. Lo) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

EYE THE WORLD (E. Boyd) - jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

REIGNING IN PARIS - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare had swelling its near foreleg and was unfit to race. Acting on this advice, Stewards declared REIGNING IN PARIS a late scratching at 1.10 pm. Trainer, Mr J. Dunn, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

I'M BULLETPROOF (J. Potter) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. RACE 7: MITAVITE - LEADERS IN EQUINE NUTRITION BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1960 metres (Cont'd)

BANRI DE HERO (L. Neindorf) - slow to begin. Made the crossing in the vicinity of the 1400 metres awkwardly.

RACE 8: EP TEMPERATURE CONTROL HANDICAP - 1210 metres

DEBEERSONUS (J. Chau) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ARTFUL RAMBLER (T. Pannell) - held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until approaching the 200 metres.

HANK'S NEPHEW (R. Hurdle) - held up from the entrance to the straight until the vicinity of the 200 metres.

BELLOMO (T. Voorham) - jumped away extremely awkwardly.

VICTOR VICTOR (J. Potter) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

HEAVENS FLIGHT (S. Fawke) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 9: HYGAIN - FEEDING CHAMPIONS FOUR-YEAR-OLD & OVER RATING 0-54 HANDICAP - 1210 metres

DOWNS AFTER DARK (A. Jordsjo) - over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had atrial fibrillation. Trainer Mr T. Montogmerie was advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to the DOWNS AFTER DARK performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

PARTY TIGER (T. Voorham) - inconvenienced on jumping away when contacted by MARIANNE RUBY.

SECRET CHARGE (C. Lions) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

GEANDGE (S. Logan) - laid in under pressure over the concluding 100 metres.

ROSIE LOUISE (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto MARIANNE RUBY.

MARIANNE RUBY (G. Lo) - hampered and lost its position on jumping away when tightened by ROSIE LOUISE onto PARTY TIGER.
