

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Parks Racecourse by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 8 Feburary 2020

RACE 1: SCHWEPPES HANDICAP - 1000 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

GOD'S PENNY (G. Lo) - laid out under pressure over the concluding stages and brushed with EXALTED QUEEN, which was taken out and contacted the hindquarters of EXALTED ZOE.

WOTUWANT (J. Eaton) – awkward to begin and shifted about shortly after the start when being restrained. Over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event. Held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until the 200 metres.

DEEVINE (S. Price) - held up from near the entrance to the straight until inside the 100 metres and was untested to the line. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TRIP (P. Gatt) – raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr D. Jolly was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

EXALTED QUEEN (C. Lions) - laid out in the straight, and taken out over the concluding stages.

EXALTED ZOE (J. Holder) - contacted over the concluding stages.

RACE 2: M&J CHICKEN HANDICAP - 1550 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

DEXTER YOU DEVIL (S. Cahill) - shifted out at the start and contacted ROSELLI STING. The near side winker became detached and fell off in the vicinity of the 200 metres. Rider reported he could offer no explanation for the performance of the gelding other than it may not have been suited to today's firmer track conditions. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PICKELHAUBE (T. Voorham) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

KARLOVASI (J. Toeroek) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ROSELLI STING (J. Chau) - re-saddled on arrival at the barriers. Contacted at the start. Laid in, in the straight.



RACE 3: DOMINANT HANDICAP - 1400 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes.

WHYKAYOH (T. Stockdale) - rider found guilty of a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

ISCARIOT (T. Pannell) - lost its off fore plate during the event.

YULONG PEENTO (J. Toeroek) - awkward to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SOWPODS - a late scratching at 11.45 am by order of Stewards on veterinary advice as the gelding was lame in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr G. Richards was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

AUTUMN SPLENDOUR (G. Lo) - awkward to begin. Laid in throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Stable Representative Mr T. Stokes advised a warning had been paced on the filly in relation to its racing manners.

BIRD OF WAR (P. Gatt) - Stewards permitted P. Gatt to ride the filly 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54kg. Rider reported the BIRD OF WAR felt awkward in its action throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed mild tying up in both hindquarters.

RACE 4: FURPHY HANDICAP - 1250 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

A KNIGHT IN PARIS (T. Pannell) - laid out in the straight.

MAGIC REWARD (R. Hurdle) - laid out under pressure over the concluding stages of the event.

SMART ALICK (D. Tourneur) – near the 800 metres when racing keenly, was inconvenienced and had to be restrained for several strides when taken in by BEDLOE'S ISLAND, which rolled in for a short distance. As a consequence SMART ALICK was unable to maintain its position, shifted out and brushed SCOUT'S HONOUR, near the 700 metres, which was taken wider on the track.

SCOUT'S HONOUR (T. Voorham) - near the 700 metres was brushed and taken out by SMART ALICK.

BEDLOE'S ISLAND (K. Bishop) - shifted out shortly after the start and contacted SIR JOHNSON. Near the 800 metres rolled in and inconvenienced SMART ALICK. A post-race veterinary examination revealed mild tying up in the hindquarters.

BUNDLE O' DIAMONDS (L. Niendorf) - awkward to begin.

RACE 5: AAMI HANDICAP - 1950 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minutes.

JACKTHEGAINTSLAYER (L. Neindorf) - had difficulty obtaining clear running for a short distance in the early part of the straight.

SEE THE MASTER (IRE) (S. Logan) - in the vicinity of the 900 metres was contacted by BEACH GOD for several strides resulting in that horse being buffeted between BEACH GOD and SAINT KATARINA.



RACE 5: AAMI HANDICAP - 1950 metres (Cont'd)

BEACH GOD (A. Jordsjo) – slow to begin. In the vicinity of the 1500 metres became awkward on the heels of JACKTHEGIANTSLAYER, got its head up and raced fiercely for some distance, until in the vicinity of the 1000 metres, placing its rider at a disadvantage. Thereafter, in the vicinity of the 900 metres, in an attempt to position her mount to the outside the heels of ZHENYA, shifted out and contacted SEE THE MASTER (IRE) for several strides resulting in that horse being buffeted between BEACH GOD and SAINT KATARINA, which maintained its line. In the vicinity of the 200 metres when improving its position became held up on the heels of ZHENYA, which was tiring and as a consequence was obliged to shift out to obtain clear running. Trainer Mr J. Hyam was advised in view of the gelding's racing manners it would be required to perform to the Stewards satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to accepting for a future race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DISCO REBEL (T. Stockdale) - slow to begin.

MAORI MAGIC (NZ) (C. Lions) - momentarily tightened near the 900 metres and hampered for several strides near the 700 metres.

SAINT KATARINA (T. Pannell) - was contacted for a number of strides in the vicinity of the 900 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer Mr D. Jolly was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

ZOFFALA (J. Holder) - inside the 800 metres shifted in momentarily tightening MAORI MAGIC (NZ) onto COBBERS MATE. Shortly thereafter, after being corrected, again shifted in near the 700 metres and tightened MAORI MAGIC (NZ), which was hampered for several strides. Rider was reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future.

RACE 6: TERRY HOME PRINTING HANDICAP - 1400 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes.

EAGLE RIDGE (J. Chau) - began awkwardly, shifted out and inconvenienced LOPE DE WOLF. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FULTON STREET (T. Pannell) - began awkwardly, shifted out and contacted PUTTING ON AIRS.

PERFECT COMMAND (T. Voorham) - rider dropped her whip in the vicinity of the 300 metres.

PUTTING ON AIRS (L. Neindorf) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

RACE 7: TAB HANDICAP - 1000 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately one minute.

TIARA STAR (L. Neindorf) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WHITE KAPS (J. Chau) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

BONNE SENSATION (J. Eaton) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

LAKE DISTRICT GIRL (T. Stockdale) – rider explained that his instructions were to allow the mare to settle where comfortable. He stated the mare began very well and was comfortable in its stride in the early and middle stages and on straightening, he was conscious of the early pace in the event and the manner in which his mount had travelled and allowed his horse every opportunity to finish the race off in the strongest possible manner by not asking it to improve too early and commenced his run from near the 300 metres. He added that the mare was disappointing over the concluding stages and did not finish the race off as expected.



RACE 7: TAB HANDICAP - 1000 metres (Cont'd)

READY SUNSHINE (T. Pannell) - rider dislodged en route to the barriers and examined by the First Care Medical Personnel and passed fit to race.

RACE 8: TAB ADELAIDE CUP DAY, MONDAY MARCH 9 HANDICAP - 1250metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minute.

BELLOMO (T. Voorham) - awkward to begin.

EXALTED TRAIL (J. Holder) - tongue-tie fitted to the gelding required adjustment on arrival at the barriers.

BROADWAY AND FIRST (K. Bishop) - inside the 700 metres became awkward inside the heels of LUCKY FLIPPER

SO SKILLED (P. Gatt) - Stable Representative Mr J. Circi informed Stewards of a change in tactics in that he would instruct the rider to be more positive and to settle forward of mid-field.

RACE 9: CHALK HILL HANDICAP - 1550metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three minutes.

OWL ON THE PROWL (K. Lau) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

DARLAMAX (T. Pannell) - Stable Representative Mr J. Cerchi informed Stewards of a change in tactics in that he would instruct the rider to be more positive and to settle forward of mid-field.

DARILJON (T. Stockdale) - awkward to begin.

KYSHAKA (T. Voorham) - rider explained her instructions were to settle back with cover and to refrain from being trapped wide at any stage during the event and to use the mare's turn of foot to finish the event off. She added that the mare failed to finish the event off in the manner the stable expected and in her opinion, the horse may have been better suited if raced in a mid-field position, and allowed to improve around the field despite being wide. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SERIOUS SPENDER (J. Chau) - laid out in the straight.

LITTLEBITFUNNY (J. Maund) - inconvenienced shortly after the start when awkward inside the heels of KYSHAKA. Slow to begin.

GENERAL:

Gawler - Saturday, 25 January 2020 RACE 9: HOLDFAST INSURANCE HANDICAP - 1200 metres

Stewards concluded an inquiry into the apparent change of tactics in respect of SEE THE MASTER (IRE) in the above mentioned race. After doing so Mr G. Young was charged under AR100(1)(b), the particulars of a charge being that Trainer Mr G. Young failed to notify Stewards of a change in instruction to S. Logan, the rider of SEE THE MASTER(IRE), to take up a forward position in running, which was different to how the horse was ridden in its most recent starts. Mr Young was found guilty for not notifying the Stewards of a change in tactics and was severely reprimanded.
