

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Kingscote Racecourse by the Kangaroo Island Racing Club on Thursday, 20 February 2020

RACE 1: ATKINS FREIGHT SERVICES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1008 metres

ULTIMATE VIEW (A. Jordsjo) - Inclined to lay in, in the straight. Rider reported the gelding did not handle the turns in today's event.

WILLIAM'S QUEST (T. Voorham) - slow to begin. Laid in, in the straight.

MINIMUM CHIPS (J. Potter) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced in over 12 months and passed fit to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MYSTIC ENDEAVOUR (S. Logan) - slow into stride. Inclined to lay in, in the straight.

RACE 2: KANGAROO ISLAND FREIGHT SERVICES / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1360 metres

CARIBBEAN SILK (J. Potter) – approaching the 400 metres, rider obliged to take hold momentarily when MR RANGER shifted out.

MR RANGER (D. Tourneur) - approaching the 400 metres shifted out onto CARIBBEAN SILK. Rider reminded of his obligations when shifting ground.

THE ULSTERMAN (K. Zechner) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Inclined to lay out in the straight.

JACK'S A CRACKER (S. Logan) - laid in, in the straight.

QUICKER THAN SLICK (S. Fawke) - rider reported the mare was under pressure in the vicinity of the 1000 metres and was disappointing in the run to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 3: G & J EAST BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1750 metres

SPLASH SOME CASH (M. Henderson) - in the vicinity of the 1350 metres hung out taking BLINKY O'REILLY wider.

CASHING UP (J. Potter) - slow to begin.

RED MENACE (D. Tourneur) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race.

CITY BEATS (E. Annells) - raced wide from the vicinity of the 1200 metres until the finish. Rider reported the gelding did not travel throughout the event and was off the bridle. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WATCH DAT STINGER (E. Boyd) - began awkwardly. Rider reported she pressed forward after beginning awkwardly however in the vicinity of the 800 metres the gelding was under pressure and lost ground considerably. She added when the gelding failed to respond to her riding she elected not to ride the gelding out for the remainder of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have some abdominal discomfort.

BLINKY O'REILLY (S. Logan) - in the vicinity of the 1350 metres was taken wider by SPLASH SOME CASH which hung out.

RACE 4: PIRATE LIFE BENCHMARK 52 HANDICAP - 1360 metres

SCOUT'S HONOUR (S. Price) – tightened over the concluding stages between CAITLIN'S ANGEL and CURTAIN CALL, which laid in.

GWENT (C. Lions) – rider reported the mare failed to run on as expected in the straight. A post race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CURTAIN CALL (D. Tourneur) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

SWANKYTOFF (J. Potter) – difficulty obtaining clear running from the vicinity of 400 meters until inside the 200 metres and from that point on was held up for the reminder of the event behind CAITLIN'S ANGEL when racing between REIGNING IN PARIS and SCOUTS HONOUR.

MISS ELEGANCE (K. Bishop) – difficulty obtaining clear running from the vicinity of the 400 metres until shifting to the inside of REIGNING IN PARIS approaching the 200 metres.

RACE 5: BUDGET RENT A CAR KANGAROO ISLAND BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1215 metres

HIGH MIST (T. Pannell) – rider stated he expected to get back in the field in this event as the gelding was dropping back in distance from its previous starts and was satisfied with his position in running trailing SAND CAT. He further added he asked the gelding to quicken when the eventual winner injected good speed into the event and was pleased with the way his mount finished over the concluding stages.

AQUESTFORVALUE (T. Voorham) – rider reported the gelding hung out throughout the event and had difficulty maintaining a straight course in the straight. Trainer David Hall Jnr was notified a warning has been on the gelding in relation to its racing manners.

EQUICHOI (S. Fawke) – approaching the 1000 metres rolled in onto MR TRUMAN tightening that runner onto BUNDLE O'DIAMONDS which was severely hampered. Rider severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised to make a greater effort when shifting ground in the future.

MR TRUMAN (J. Chau) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Approaching the 1000 metres was tightened for racing room between EQUICHOI, which had rolled in, and BUNDLE O' DIAMONDS, and as a consequence shied away from EQUICHOI and shifted in onto BUNDLE O' DIAMONDS, severely hampering that runner.



RACE 5: BUDGET RENT A CAR KANGAROO ISLAND BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1215 metres (Cont'd)

BUNDLE O' DIAMONDS (K. Bishop) – approaching the 1000 metres was severely hampered by MR TRUMAN, which shifted in and away from EQUICHOI.

SPIRITOS (M. Collett) – approaching the 1000 metres was inconvenienced by BUNDLE OF DIAMONDS which had lost ground after being hampered, and became unbalanced for several strides.

RACE 6: BUDGET RENT A CAR KANGAROO ISLAND BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1008 metres

OLD TRIESTE (J. Chau) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course as it had become fractious in its float en route to the course. OLD TRIESTE was ruled unfit to race. Acting on this advice stewards withdrew OLD TRIESTE at 11.36am.

NIC'S SECRET (R. Hurdle) - hung out in the vicinity of the 300 metres when rounding the home turn.

NEED THE YEN (T. Pannell) – laid out under pressure over the concluding stages.

SHALL WE HOPE (M. Henderson) – rider reported from the wide barrier draw he was unable to settle on the pace where the gelding prefers to race. A post race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FLORID (E. Boyd) – slow to begin. Inclined to lay in, in the straight.

RACE 7: BUDGET RENT A CAR KANGAROO ISLAND BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1880 metres

MAORI MAGIC (NZ) (C. Lions) - raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

SENTRY GATE (S. Fawke) – reared as the start was effected and as a result was slow to begin.

SPUDFEST (E. Boyd) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. Rider reported the gelding weakened from approaching the 400 metres. A post race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

GENERAL:

Following a routine stable inspection on the 21 January 2020, trainer Mr G. Young was fined \$200 under the provisions of AR104(1) for failing to provide an up to date record of medication or treatment that had been administered to horses in his stable.
