Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 25 July 2020

RACE 1 HAPPY 60TH GRANT "JOCK" JENNINGS HANDICAP - 2000 Metres

WOOLSTHORPE STORE (C. Jones) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BERTWHISTLE (K. Crowther) - held up for clear running from inside the 400 metres until near the 200 metres.

EXALTED RUTH (T. Voorham) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

OURKHANI (J. Toeroek) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event and was inclined to lay in, in the straight.

RACE 2: AAMI HANDICAP - 2500 Metres

MANZALA (J. Eaton) - Trainer Ms. A. Downing advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics, that being that she would instruct her rider not to lead and attempt to settle further back if possible. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

TURF MAN (S. Fawke) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HASTA LA FIORENTE (B. Vorster) – commenced to over-race shortly after the start, got its head up and raced ungenerously for some distance before settling.

RACE 3: TAB HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

CALYPSO REIGN (K. Crowther) - over-raced in the early stages of the event.

DEEVINE (P. Gatt) – over-raced in the early stages of the event. Rider reported that he became concerned with the gelding's action over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HATEECH (J. Toeroek) - Stewards permitted J. Toeroek to ride the filly 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54 kg. Rider reported that he became concerned with the filly's action from in the vicinity of the 300 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 3: TAB HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (Cont.)

NEEDA (T. Voorham) – rider explained she had no set instructions, but given the apparent pace in the event she was of the view she should be able to get cover in the early stages. She stated the filly began better than expected and in comparison to its last start at Gawler on 11/7/20, and as a consequence she was obliged to settle forward when trapped three wide without cover in the early stages. She added this racing pattern did not suit the filly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in the off hind leg. Trainer Mr S. Adams was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

RACE 4: FURPHY HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

STAR OF MONSOON (T. Pannell) - lost it's off fore plate during the event.

FANCY RUMBLE (D. Tourneur) - contacted at the start.

BEERMINT (A. Jordsjo) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SCHILLDORA (J. Toeroek) - inclined to lay in, in the early part of the straight. Shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages. Rider was reminded of his obligations when using his whip to ensure he does not raise his arm above shoulder height.

AKKACAN (J. Eaton) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Was inclined to lay in, in the straight.

ROCK HARD (J. Holder) - awkward to begin, shifted out and contacted FANCY RUMBLE.

NASIFA (J. Maund) - held up for clear running from near the 400 metres until in the vicinity of the 200 metres and was obliged to shift out wider to obtain clear running.

RACE 5: DOMINANT HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

CROWN FONTEIN (S. Fawke) - shifted in shortly after the start onto COLUMBIA which was tightened onto EXTREME THRILL, resulting in COLUMBIA having to be steadied to avoid CROWN FONTEIN'S heels and EXTREME THRILL being taken in and tightened onto the heels of OCTANE. As a consequence EXTREME THRILL had to be checked and lost its position. S. Fawke pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) in that he shifted in when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on 5 August and to conclude at midnight on 9 August 2020; a period of three (3) meetings. Lost it's near fore plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

USTINOV'S FURY (J. Potter) - which had not raced since December 2018 was examined by the veterinary surgeon on arrival on course and was passed fit to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

COLUMBIA (T. Pannell) - was tightened at the start by CROWN FONTEIN and taken in onto EXTREME THRILL.

OCTANE (K. Crowther) - raced keen and wide without cover in the early stages of the event.

SOUL FIRE (D. Tourneur) - which had not raced since December 2019 was examined by the veterinary surgeon on arrival on course and was passed fit to race. Began awkwardly, shifted out and contacted MR HAMILTON.

RAINMOTH (J. Toeroek) - which had not raced since November 2019 was examined by the veterinary surgeon on arrival on course and was passed fit to race.



RACE 5: DOMINANT HANDICAP - 1100 Metres (Cont'd)

EXTREME THRILL (K. Bishop) - was taken in and tightened at the start, had to be checked when awkward on the heels of OCTANE and lost its position.

MR HAMILTON (J. Eaton) - contacted at the start.

RACE 6: SCHWEPPES HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

ENKI (T. Voorham) - slow to begin. Raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

SO WE ARE (C. Jones) - laid in, in the straight.

THE ANT'S PANTS (K. Crowther) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: TAB LIGHTNING STAKES - 1050 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately three (3) minutes owing to a number of runners proving fractious at the barriers, JUST ZERENE proving difficult to load and the tongue tie on FLOSTAR having to be refitted on two occasions.

STREETCAR STRANGER (P. Gatt) - shortly after the entrance to the straight shifted out to improve around the heels of JUST ZERENE and in doing so took the running of GARVOC which was weakening, resulting in GARVOC being momentarily hampered. P. Gatt was severely reprimanded for shifting ground when insufficiently clear.

FLOSTAR (C. Jones) - was examined by the veterinary surgeon after arrival on course and was passed fit to race. On arrival at the barriers had its tongue tie refitted, and had its off fore plate refitted by the course farrier. Was examined by the veterinary surgeon and passed fit to race. Shortly thereafter had its tongue tie refitted again.

JUST ZERENE (B. Vorster) - proved difficult to load.

GARVOC (T. Pannell) - raced fiercely in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SUPREME IDEA (D. Tourneur) - was taken wider near the 200 metres by EUPHORIC SUMMER which shifted out to improve. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly had blood in its mouth owing to contusions and swelling to the off side of its mouth.

EUPHORIC SUMMER (E. Boyd) – contacted at the start. Near the entrance to the straight, when attempting to improve between SUPREME IDEA and SIZZLEFLY, was initially disappointed for clear ground, and was obliged to shift to the inside of SUPREME IDEA to gain clear running. Thereafter EUPHORIC SUMMER shifted to the outside of SIZZLEFLY to improve and near the 200 metres shifted out onto SUPREME IDEA taking that horse wider on the track. E. Boyd was reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground in future. Rider reported that the filly did not race in a tractable manner and shifted ground both ways during the event.

PARLOPHONE (J. Eaton) - shifted out at the start and contacted EUPHORIC SUMMER. Laid in, in the straight.

ALLEZ SUR LE GRIS (K. Crowther) – over-raced in the early stages of the event.



RACE 8: HOLDFAST INSURANCE HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

RED DYNAMO (NZ) (K. Bishop) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using her whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded. Rider reminded of her obligation to ride her mounts out to the finish.

MIDNIGHT STORM (J. Eaton) - for a short distance from inside the 800 metres raced in restricted room to the inside of CALL ME DEXTER, which, when racing without cover, shifted in, in an attempt to obtain cover.

PARK BENCH (NZ) (J. Holder) – very awkward and slow to begin. Rider reported that the gelding commenced to weaken from near the 300 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

I'M A LEGEND (A. Jordsjo) - slow to begin. Approaching the 700 metres, when awkwardly placed on the heels of MIDNIGHT STORM, got its head up and over-raced for a short distance. Held up for clear running for a short distance rounding the home turn.

CALL ME DEXTER (S. Fawke) – for a short distance inside the 800 metres when racing wide without cover shifted in, in an attempt to obtain cover and inconvenienced MIDNIGHT STORM which was obliged to race in restricted room for a short distance. S. Fawke was reminded of his obligations when shifting ground. Rider reported that the gelding over-raced in the early stages and he was unable to obtain cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg. Trainer Mr G. Fryer was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to presenting the horse for a future trial or race.

THE DIFFERENCE (B. Vorster) - over-raced in the early stages of the event.

RACE 9: TAB HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

QUIDDICK (D. Caboche) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Approaching the 700 metres shifted in and tightened THE RAVEN which was hampered and got its head up and commenced to race ungenerously as a consequence. D. Caboche was severely reprimanded and advised to take greater care when shifting ground. Inside the 200 metres shifted in onto ROSE TIARA and tightened that horse onto MIAMI FREEDOM which had commenced to weaken, resulting in ROSE TIARA being hampered for several strides when taken in. D. Caboche was severely reprimanded and advised to ensure he stops and straightens his mounts, when they commence to shift ground, sooner than he did on this occasion.

MIAMI FREEDOM (J. Eaton) – lost its near hind plate during the event. Inside the 200 metres when weakening was momentarily tightened when racing in restricted room to the inside of ROSE TIARA which was taken in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AIR MARSHAL (J. Toeroek) - was unable to maintain its position shortly after the start when tightened. Laid out under pressure over the concluding stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

KINGSON (K. Zechner) - over-raced in the early stages of the event.

FRENCH ROCK (D. Tourneur) - was held up for clear running from approaching the 500 metres until approaching the 300 metres, where it became awkward inside the heels of MUSICAL QUERY which rolled in, was hampered and had to be restrained.

MUSICAL QUERY (T. Voorham) - began awkwardly, shifted out and contacted THE RAVEN which was taken wider into the running line of AIR MARSHALL. Over-raced in the early stages of the event.

ROSE TIARA (T. Pannell) - was held up for a short distance inside the 500 metres, and thereafter inside the 200 metres was again unable to improve its position when tightened by QUIDDICK which shifted in, and as a consequence was hampered for several strides.



RACE 9: TAB HANDICAP - 1100 Metres (Cont'd)

THE RAVEN (J. Potter) - which had not raced since November 2019 was examined by the veterinary surgeon on arrival on course and was passed fit to race. Contacted at the start and taken wider across the running of AIR MARSHALL. Near the 700 metres became awkward inside the heels of QUIDDICK which shifted in, got its head up and raced ungenerously for a short distance thereafter. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

WONDER IF (NZ) (P. Gatt) - knuckled at the start.

SONIC DEED (B. Vorster) - lost its off fore plate during the event.
