

THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Strathalbyn Racecourse by the Strathalbyn Racing Club on Sunday, 29 November 2020

<u>Stewards</u>: C. Deakin (A/Chairman), & M. Santoro (HT) (Stewards), E. Scott (F) & D. Jonas (M) (Cadet Stewards), E. Tickner & J. Hittmann (Deputy Stewards), Dr P. Horridge (Veterinary Surgeon).

WEATHER: Fine

RACE 1: LAKE BREEZE / SABOIS DISTANCE MAIDEN PLATE - 2050 Metres

ADVENTURE WORLD (GER) (T. Pannell) - over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event and commenced to give ground from the 700 metres. Rider explained the gelding would not settle in the early and middle stages and did not respond to his riding from the 700 metres and for that reason he did not ride his mount out in his usual manner to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg. Trainer, Mr M. Hickmott, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

BOLSHOI BOY (NZ) (J. Toeroek) - laid in, in the straight.

RACE 2: LANGHORNE CREEK WINE REGION / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 Metres

BLACK CHEVAL (S. Fawke) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

GUNFIREINTHECITY - got down in its race day tie-up stall. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and found to be lame in the near hind leg. Acting on this advice Stewards declared GUNFIREINTHECITY a late scratching at 1.12 pm.

GLENARCH BAY (D. Stra) - laid out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: GLENAVON NURSERIES / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

ANJAH (E. Boyd) - approaching the 200 metres became held up between AGAAREB and CHARADE, which rolled in. Inside the 200 metre shifted out to obtain clear running across the running of NANAMU. Rider was severely reprimanded under AR131(a) and advised in future to take hold and not pass her predicament on to someone else.

CHARADE (D. Tootell) - tightened on jumping away. Approaching the 200 metres rolled in. Rider reminded of his obligations and to straighten his mounts as soon as they commence to shift ground.

ELECTRUM (C. Jones) - hit its head in the starting gates. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race.

RACE 3: GLENAVON NURSERIES / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres (Cont'd)

GO BOO BOO (R. Hurdle) - held up from the 200 metres until approaching the 100 metres and obliged to shift to the outside of OUR TREASURE TROVE to obtain clear running.

LEANNA BELLE (P. Gatt) - held up between the 300 metres and the 200 metres. Lost its off fore plate during the event.

NANAMU (S. Logan) - inside the 200 metres was obliged to be steadied and shifted in to avoid the heels of ANJAH.

WANT THE TRUTH (D. Caboche) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped CHARADE.

AQAAREB (S. Fawke) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

MERVA (B. Vorster) - rider explained the filly never travelled throughout the event, was under pressure in the straight and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SEE YOU LATER NOW (J. Holder) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped CHARADE.

RACE 4: BREMERTON WINES CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

DAZZLING DAMSEL (T. Pannell) - shortly after the start dipped for no apparent reason.

A KNIGHT IN PARIS (C. Lions) - slow to begin. Laid out in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HOLY TORMENT (K. Crowther) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

LORD ROSENTHAL (J. Opperman) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. Rider explained the gelding never travelled throughout the event and when placed under pressure inside the 700 metres, failed to respond to his riding. Co-Trainer Mr C. Binnie was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding for being uncompetitive.

RACE 5: LANGHORNE CREEK VIGNERONS' CUP - 1350 Metres

ENKI (D. Stra) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Rider was reminded of her obligations under AR131(b) in that she failed to rider her mount out to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CARAK (J. Holder) - slow to begin.

RACE 6: GIPSIE JACK BM 54 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

CARBONE (J. Eaton) - jumped away awkwardly.

THE STOCKBROKER (J. Opperman) - jumped away awkwardly.

EXALTED QUEEN (S. So) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

PERUVIAN EXPRESS (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly. Laid out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DABAY (D. Stra) - shortly after the start shifted out and away from CARBONE and contacting the hindquarters of KEYSOR.



RACE 7: BLEASDALE VINEYARDS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

VARACALLI LAD (Z. White) - raced ungenerously throughout the event. In the vicinity of the 1400 metres rolled out and contacted the hindquarters of AZDAJA, resulting in that mare rolling in tightening the running of VARACALLI LAD. Shortly after VARACALLI LAD hung out across the heels of AZDAJA tightening the running of CHONCAPE. Inside the 800 metres, whilst being restrained hung out tightening the running of EVENING SPICE. Trainer Mr D. O'Leary was advised that the gelding must now prove tractable in an Official Barrier Trial or Approval to Race Jump Out prior to accepting for a future race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CHONCAPE (P. Gatt) - inside the 1400 metres was obliged to be checked to avoid the heels of VARACALLI LAD.

HILUMIERE (C. Lions) - slow to begin.

TIZA (C. Jones) - slow to begin.

SCHERZER (B. Vorster) - inside the 800 metres was obliged to shift out to avoid the heels of EVENING SPICE, taking RIGHT AND READY wider. Held up on the heels of INDIAN MO from the 100 metres and was untested to the line.

HOLY SANGRIA (J. Maund) - jumped away awkwardly.

RIGHT AND READY (L. Halliday) - inside the 800 metres was taken wider on the track.

EVENING SPICE (S. Logan) - inside the 800 metres was tightened between SOLAAZEM and VARACALLI LAD, which hung out and was obliged to be checked and lose its position.
