Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville by
the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 31
July 2021

(Heaviest category track, very wet, towards saturation)

RACE 1: TERRY HOWE PRINTING MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 Metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately two minutes to avoid a clash with an interstate race.

OAK DAM (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly.

ITALIAN VIKING (B. Vorster) - in the vicinity of the 200 metres had its hindquarters contacted by STASIA (NZ) which had been taken out resulting in the gelding being turned inwards and shifting back in onto STASIA (NZ). ITALIAN VIKING laid in for the remainder of the event.

SELF SUFFICIENT (J. Holder) - rider accidentally dropped his whip approaching the finish.

THROWAPARTY (S. Logan) - laid out under pressure in the straight. In approaching the 200 metres shifted out onto STASIA (NZ). Rider was reminded of her obligations and advised in future to make a greater effort to straighten her mounts when they commenced to shift. Lost its near fore plate during the event.

LADY ZOOM (P. Gatt) - jumped away awkwardly.

STASIA (NZ) (J. Eaton) - approaching the 200 metres was hampered and lost its position when tightened between THROWAPARTY which shifted out and ITALIAN VIKING which shifted in after being contacted.



RACE 2: ADELAIDE GALVANISING HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

DOMINUS (NZ) (K. Crowther) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

REYNOLDS (GB) (J. Eaton) – jumped away awkwardly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ALLUSION (P. Gatt) – rider reported that the gelding did not feel comfortable after entering the straight and on pulling up he formed the opinion that the gelding had choked down.

STAR STATUS (C. Jones) – slow to begin.

RACE 3: THE JUNCTION HANDICAP - 1500 Metres

The start of this race was delayed approximately one minute to avoid a clash with an interstate race.

CLAP (J. Toeroek) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted in onto TALAMO (NZ).

VICTORY CLUB (T. Pannell) – contacted on jumping away. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

THE BRUMBY (B. Vorster) – lost its near hind plate during the event.

BLAH BLAH BLAH (D. Tourneur) – laid in under pressure in the straight.

SPINOLA BAY (K. Zechner) – shifted on jumping away contacting VICTORY CLUB.

YURI ROYALE (J. Maund) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event, hung out rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight. Rider reported that the gelding hung out throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TALAMO (NZ) (J. Eaton) – contacted on jumping away. Rider reported that she had placed the gelding under pressure in the vicinity of the 400 metres however it failed to respond to her riding and was disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: FURPHY HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

JYOTI (B. Vorster) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WOTUWANT (R. Hurdle) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

YULONG PHELPS (T. Pannell) – rider reported that the colt never travelled during the event and when asked for an effort was disappointing. He added that in his opinion YULONG PHELPS did not handle the track condition. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

COTILLION (E. Boyd) – slow into stride.

CHOSEN BLONDE (J. Eaton) – laid out under pressure in the straight.

RACE 5: HAPPY 40TH JASON GENTLE HANDICAP - 2500 Metres

CARRIE (JPN) (J. Holder) – in the vicinity of the 400 metres had to take hold when tightened onto CLEVER MAN by EXALTED AMBITION which shifted out slightly. Rider reported that the mare was under pressure from the vicinity of the 600 metres and in his opinion did not handle the track condition. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RUDIMENTAL (FR) (J. Eaton) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.





RACE 5: HAPPY 40TH JASON GENTLE HANDICAP - 2500 Metres (cont'd)

EXALTED AMBITION (T. Pannell) - in the vicinity of the 400 metres shifted out slightly in an attempt to improve to the outside of LORD BOUZERON (NZ) and in doing so tightened CARRIE (JPN) onto CLEVER MAN. Rider was severely reprimanded for careless riding under AR131(a) and advised in future to ensure he was sufficiently clear prior to commencing to shift ground.

RACE 6: ACCOLADE WINES HANDICAP - 1800 Metres

MASTER CHUM (T. Pannell) - rider reported that the gelding travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event however when placed under pressure failed to respond to his riding and in his opinion did not handle the track condition. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DENERO (J. Eaton) - rider reported that the gelding had choked down on pulling up.

MUNTHAM MISSILE (D. Tourneur) - trainer, Ms B. O'Loughlin put a submission to Stewards that the mare not race in pacifiers today due to the heavy track rating and kick back. Stewards acceded to this request and permitted MUNTHAM MISSILE to race without pacifiers. Slow to begin.

RACE 7: LEADER COMPUTERS, LOCALLY BUILT, PROUDLY AUSTRALIAN HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

BRIMARVI VEHERO (D. Tourneur) - trainer, Mr. S. Burford put a submission to Stewards that the gelding be scratched due to the track downgrade. Stewards acceded to this request and declared BRIMARVI VEHERO a late scratching at 3:01 pm.

TAKEN OFF (K. Crowther) - lost its off fore plate during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CAN'T BE DONE (M. Aitken) - A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HE'S A BALTER (K. Zechner) - Stewards questioned rider into the tactics adopted in this event in particular that he had not presented and placed the gelding under pressure until in the vicinity of the 200 metres. K. Zechner advised that he had been instructed that HE'S A BALTER only has a short sprint and to not present it too early in the event. Trainer, Mr. W. Clarken confirmed the instructions.

RACE 8: TAB LIGHTNING STAKES - 1050 Metres

MAHA (B. Vorster) - jumped away awkwardly, raced wide without cover throughout the event, inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

DIRTY THOUGHTS (M. Aitken) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

PEGGY SELENE (D. Tourneur) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed excess upper respiratory noise and an elevated heart rate. Co-trainers, Mr C. Maher and Mr D. Eustace, were advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness and the results of a laryngoscopic examination were required prior to a future race or trial.

PARLOPHONE (K. Crowther) - laid in under pressure in the straight.

RACE 9: BLIGHT'S ELECTRICAL HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

GIGGLON (E. Boyd) - shifted out shortly after the start onto HALCYON DAME.

ANGASTON (K. Zechner) - shifted in shortly after the start onto HALCYON DAME.



RACE 9: BLIGHT'S ELECTRICAL HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

EXTRA MILE (J. Toeroek) - rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(6)(b) in that he used his whip in an action that raised his used his whip in an action that raised his arm above shoulder height and was reprimanded.

MISS JANE (P. Gatt) - approaching the 100 metres became unbalanced for a short distance when contacted by VIOLINIST which laid in and as a result shifted in and away onto ECHOES IN ETERNITY. Rider reported that the gelding hung out over the concluding 600 metres of the event.

HALCYON DAME (K. Crowther) - shortly after the start lost its position when tightened between GIGGLON which shifted out and ANGASTON which shifted in. Shifted out slightly approaching the 100 metres onto ECHOES IN ETERNITY.

ECHOES IN ETERNITY (J. Eaton) - in the vicinity of the 100 metres had to be steadied and lost its position when tightened between HALCYON DAME which out slightly at the same time as MISS JANE shifted in and away from VIOLINIST. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

VIOLINIST (B. Vorster) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid in, in the straight and approaching the 100 metres shifted in contacting MISS JANE which was taken in.

General: Following the running of race four today Stewards conducted an inspection of the male and female jockeys' rooms in relation to mobile phones.

Jockeys R. Hurdle, J. Maund and B. Vorster provided their mobile phones to Stewards at the first opportunity and explained that they had the phones in their possession to QR Code on their way into the course and when they arrived at the jockeys' room discovered that the Jockey Room Attendant was not on duty today due to COVID restrictions and for this reason they had placed their phones in their bags as they were unable to be locked in the valuables cupboard. After considering their explanations Stewards charged jockeys R. Hurdle, J. Maund and B. Vorster under AR218(4)(b) in that they did have in their possession in the jockeys' room a mobile telephone. The riders all pleaded guilty and were fined \$100 each. In determining penalty Stewards took into account the particular circumstances in relation to why the riders had their phones and also that Stewards were able to confirm that the riders had not used their phones in any manner from the time they had arrived in the jockeys' room.
