Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Morphettville Racecourse by the South Australian Jockey Club on Saturday, 18 September 2021

INTERIM REPORT

RACE 1: WILLS & DANIEL HANDICAP - 1100 Metresa

KARACASU (J. Toeroek) - awkward to begin.

MAGIC MAX (B. Price) – contacted at the start. Over-raced in the early stages of the event. Inclined to lay in, in the straight. Rider reported that it was his intention to settle further back in running; however, the gelding began better than expected and over-raced for the first 300 metres of the event resulting in him being obliged to settle forward.

HANABI (K. Crowther) - began awkwardly, shifted out and contacted MAGIC MAX. Inclined to lay in, in the straight.

MADAM FURPHY (S. Logan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FOUR WINDS (D. Tourneur) – slipped behind on jumping away and as a consequence was slow to begin. Rider reported that as a consequence of being slow to begin he was unable to take up a more forward position as intended.

RACE 2: FLEURIEU MILK COMPANY HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

MAYAN (B. Vorster) – commenced to over-race from near the 1000 metres and thereafter shifted out and raced wide without cover from near the 800 metres. Lost its off fore plate in running.

THRILL KILL (R. Hurdle) - held up from near the 400 metres until inside the 300 metres.

SO YOU CAN (J. Holder) – awkward to begin, shifted out and contacted PREAKNESS (NZ). Raced keenly in the early stages of the event. Laid out over the concluding stages of the event. Rider reported that the gelding failed to let down and was disappointing in its finishing effort. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



RACE 2: FLEURIEU MILK COMPANY HANDICAP - 1200 Metres (cont'd)

GOT MY THRILLS (NZ) (E. Finnegan) – trainer, Mr T. Doudle, failed to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card for the mare. GOT MY THRILLS (NZ) was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by Stewards. Laid out for a short distance rounding the home turn and was awkward in its action in the straight. Rider reported that she had become concerned with the mare's action behind in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PREAKNESS (NZ) (J. Eaton) - contacted at the start. Laid out under pressure over the concluding stages of the event.

MUMBLES (S. Logan) - slow to begin.

HI SMOKEY (J. Potter) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: TERRY HOWE PRINTING MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 Metres

BOSSPAN (J. Eaton) – awkward and slow to begin. Shortly thereafter commenced to over-race and inside the 900 metres got its head up when being restrained and raced very ungenerously for a number of strides.

AITCH D'AMICO (C. Murray) – near the 700 metres was brushed by LOOKING FORWARD, which shifted out when over-racing, and was taken out into the running line of YEELANNA, which had to be steadied. Approaching the 100 metres was obliged to race in restricted room between BOSSPAN, which rolled out slightly, and YEELANNA, which was inclined to lay in and shifted in slightly.

VAMPIRE SLAYER (J. Opperman) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

YEELANNA (P. Gatt) - near the 700 metres had to be steadied when AITCH D'AMICO was brushed and taken out by LOOKING FORWARD, which shifted out when over-racing.

DANCING STREAM (D. Caboche) – Stewards permitted D. Caboche to ride the filly 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.0 kg. Shifted ground in both directions from inside the 100 metres and momentarily inconvenienced STRATISFACTION inside the 100 metres as that horse shifted in and away from DANCING STREAM.

STRATISFACTION (T. Voorham) - raced keenly in the early stages. Momentarily inconvenienced by DANCING STREAM inside the 100 metres.

LOOKING FORWARD (S. So) – trainer, Mr S. Schrader, advised Stewards prior to the event of a change of tactics in that he would instruct his rider to be positive early and take up a forward position if possible. Settled back of midfield. Over-raced in the early stages of the event. Near the 700 metres, when over-racing, shifted out and brushed AITCH D'AMICO, which was taken out into the running line of YEELANNA, which had to be steadied. Rider reported that after the horse was a little slow to begin it failed to muster early speed and as a consequence she was unable to take up a more forward position as intended.

RACE 4: SPRING RACING CARNIVAL AT MORPHETTVILLE - OCT. 9 - NOV. 6 HANDICAP - 1050 Metres

ROCK HARD (J. Opperman) - over-raced in the early stages of the event.

TULLYS GOLD (T. Pannell) – over-raced in the early stages of the event. Inclined to lay out over the concluding stages of the event.

ATOMIC LOKADE (T. Voorham) – awkward and slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



LA VITA (J. Toeroek) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 5: QUAYCLEAN HANDICAP - 1200 Metres

TOMMY BLUE (G. Lo) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

AIGUILETTE (P. Gatt) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LAKE'S FOLLY (J. Eaton) - rider reported that the gelding raced flat when asked for an effort and did not quicken as expected in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STRYKE IN STYLE (S. Metcalfe) - was examined by the Club's Veterinary Surgeon pre-race who reported that the gelding was exhibiting mild symptoms of colic and would be unfit to start. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew STRYKE IN STYLE at 2.16 pm.

RACE 6: SCHILD ESTATE HANDICAP - 2000 Metres

UNDER OATH (M. Aitken) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TINANDALI (IRE) (J. Eaton) – awkward to begin. After passing the crossing near the 1800 metres got its head up and raced ungenerously for a short distance and thereafter raced keenly for some distance. Just prior to the winning post was obliged to race in restricted room between ALL HARD WOOD and MELODY MAN, which both shift ground.

EXALTED AMBITION (B. Price) - shifted in at the start and contacted GALAHAD GURU. Raced wide without cover in the early stages of the event.

HINCHPIN (B. Vorster) - slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MELODY MAN (T. Pannell) - shifted out over the concluding stages.

GALAHAD GURU (J. Holder) - shifted out at the start and contacted EXALTED AMBITION.

ALL HARD WOOD (J. Maund) – laid in, in the straight and shifted in over the concluding stages. Rider explained that while it was his intention to settle more forward, he was unable to do so owing to the manner in which the gelding began and having regard for his wide barrier and the formation of the field in the early stages of the event. As a consequence he was obliged to take cover and settle behind the speed. Lost its off hind plate in running.

UNDERSTATEMENT (D. Tourneur) - slow to begin.


RACE 7: KARIN BRADBROOK HAPPY 50TH HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

LOMAX (J. Potter) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JAAMINT (J. Eaton) - shifted in under pressure approaching the 100 metres and inconvenienced GIVE ME TEN (NZ).

CASTLE OF KINGS (NZ) (T. Pannell) – acting on advice from trainer, Mr W. Clarken, that the gelding had mucous present in its nostrils and would be unfit to race Stewards withdrew CASTLE OF KINGS (NZ) at 12.28 pm.

GIVE ME TEN (NZ) (G. Lo) – laid out in the straight and approaching the 100 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of JAAMINT, which shifted in under pressure, and as a consequence had to be steadied. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



SKY HERO (C. Murray) - slow to begin. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.





SO BENE (C. Jones) - Stewards permitted C. Jones to ride the mare 0.5 kg over its declared weight of 54.5 kg.

BACK POCKET (J. Maund) - rider reported that he felt that the gelding may have been sore behind. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: W H WYLIE HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

MORVADA (K. Zechner) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

BOLD STAR (J. Holder) - over-raced in the early stages of the event.

FREE OF DEBT (G. Lo) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR131(c) for making a celebratory gesture prior to the winning post and was fined \$200.

STREET TOUGH (T. Pannell) - Stewards granted permission for T. Pannell to ride the gelding 1.0 kg over its declared weight of 54 kg. Contacted at the start.

PARLOPHONE (J. Eaton) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DIAMONDS (A. Jordsjo) - shifted out at the start and tightened PIMM'S PARTY.

PIMM'S PARTY (T. Voorham) – jumped away awkwardly and contacted STREET TOUGH and thereafter was tightened between STREET TOUGH and DIAMONDS, which shifted out, and as a consequence was unable to maintain its position shortly after the start and lost ground.

SPECIALISM (E. Finnegan) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 9: GRAND SYNDICATES - RACE WITH TEAM GRAND HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

MAGIC PHANTOM (G. Lo) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

RANGER FRANK (J. Potter) - shifted out and contacted WILD TYCOON, and shortly thereafter was inconvenienced by WILD TYCOON as that horse shifted in after becoming unbalanced.

RITORNO (K. Zechner) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer, Mr C. Reardon, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

DEBBONAIRE BOY (J. Opperman) – jumped away awkwardly and contacted WILD TYCOON, which became unbalanced when tightened onto RANGER FRANK, which shifted out on jumping away. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ALL IN WAR (B. Price) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed a small abrasion to the inside of its near hock.

ASTON RAPOVA (B. Vorster) - raced keenly in the early stages of the event.

WILD TYCOON (R. Hurdle) - became unbalanced at the start when contacted and tightened onto RANGER FRANK by DEBBONAIRE BOY, which jumped a way awkwardly and shifted in. Near the 500 metres appeared to clip the heels of ALL IN WAR and dipped. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.
