# Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Penola Racecourse by the Penola Racing Club on Sunday, 10 October 2021

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## RACE 1: THE MIDFIELD GROUP MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 Metres

BADONKIDONK (E. Annells) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced greenly when placed under pressure in the straight and shifted ground.

KEETTOM (E. Finnegan) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

TOMMY TOMATO (S. Logan) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and crowed DISCO TILMORN. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event and near the 800 metres got its head up when being restrained away from the heels of YOUR OUTATOUCH

DISCO TILMORN (C. Jones) - crowded at the start between YOUR OUTATOUCH and TOMMY TOMATO, which shifted out.

MELISSA KATE (NZ) (B. Price) - Slow to begin. Bumped the enclosure gate when returning to the parade ring. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PARIS DOLL (G. Lo) - raced greenly throughout the event.

TROUBLED TIMES (E. Boyd) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. Rider reported the mare hung out throughout, proved difficult to ride in the straight and in her opinion was not confident racing in amongst the field.

#### RACE 2: BETTY FOWLES 100TH BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION F&M BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

SCEI both force

GLASS CEILING (A. Livesey) – hung out from the 300 metres when placed under pressure, placing SCENIC HOST and WIRLIES LASTCHANCE in restricted room near the 200 metres and forced both horses wider in the straight. STAR JAN, which was racing on their outside was consequently forced wider on the track.



#### RACE 2: BETTY FOWLES 100TH BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION F&M BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres (Cont'd)

STAR JAN (J. Opperman) – forced wider on the track from the 300 metres.

SCENIC HOST (D. Tourneur) – forced wide from the 300 metres by GLASS CEILING from its inside and placed in restricted room near the 200 metres between that horse and WURLIES LASTCHANCE.

WURLIES LASTCHANCE (D. Caboche) – forced wider from the 300 metres and placed in restricted room between STAR JAN and SCENIC HOST, which was forced wider near the 200 metres.

## RACE: 3 DI GIORGIO FAMILY WINES BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1100 Metres

RHYTHMATIC (A. Livesey) - jumped away awkwardly with its head up. Approaching the 100 metres was obliged to shift out wider on the track to obtain clear ground.

GETONIT (L. Halliday) – Stewards questioned rider on the gelding's performance from the 400 metres, rider explained that approaching the 400 metres a run appeared between REAL VALENTIA and EQUICHUNK however, the gelding was unable to sprint with the field. She added that near the 200 metres the run commenced to close and at that stage GETONIT was commencing to lay in behind REAL VALENTIA. She further added that the gelding was held up from the 150 metres behind both horses, which were weakening. Co-Trainer Mr K. Post explained he was disappointed in the ride and believes the rider should have used more vigour. He added the gelding performs best under hard riding and intends to use a stronger rider in future. Rider was advised by Stewards that she should have used more vigour from the 400 metres until near the 200 metres as in their opinion, a run was available for her to improve into. Although consideration was given to issue a charge under AR129(2) for failing to take "reasonable and permissible measures", Stewards were mindful of Ms Halliday's lack of experience and skill level and therefore referred Ms Halliday to the Riding Skills Panel under LR38.4.1.

FERGIE (E. Finnegan) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

EQUICHUNK (E. Boyd) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CIBACHROME (T. Voorham) - held up between runners from the 400 metres until the 200 metres and shifted out to obtain clear ground.

## RACE 4: ADRIAN THOMAS INDUSTRIAL MAIDEN PLATE - 1300 Metres

ANGRY ANT (A. Livesey) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

LOVE TO LOVE (S. Logan) - raced in restricted room over the concluding stages and had to be eased off heels.

STREUSEL (NZ) (L. Halliday) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course as it had not raced for some time and was passed fit to race. Slow to begin. Tailed the field by a considerable distance for majority of the race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding suffered atrial fibrillation. Co-Trainer Mr K. Post was advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

THIRTY TWO GUNS (A. Jordsjo) - slow to begin.

IT'S ALL GOSSIP (C. Lions) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

JELLY BEAN CLUB (G. Lo) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Raced greenly approaching the 400 metres and lost ground when racing between NANCY MAY and ROLL ME AWAY.



NANCY MAY (J. Potter) – Trainer Mr R. Schultz advised Stewards that due to transport difficulties, the mare would be late on course. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

## RACE 4: ADRIAN THOMAS INDUSTRIAL MAIDEN PLATE - 1300 Metres (Cont'd)

ROLL ME AWAY (B. Price) – rider reported that he was concerned with the mare's action in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SURREAL STORM (J. Opperman) - slow to begin.

VONDEXTER (A. Chung) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

#### RACE 5: COOPERS KALANGADOO CUP BENCHMARK 70 HANDICAP - 1600 Metres

BLACK SYRAH (D. Tourneur) - slow to begin. Shifted out near the 400 metres when insufficiently clear of ALI ORPHAN, which had to be eased. Rider was advised to exercise more care in similar circumstances.

ALI ORPHAN (NZ) (K. Walters) - eased near the 400 metres away from the heels of BLACK SYRAH, which shifted out.

THE ARMANI (NZ) (L. Halliday) - slow to begin.

### RACE 6: TAB BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 2100 Metres

FAST FOILS (NZ) (L. Halliday) – rider reported the gelding laid in from the 1100 metres. She added that she was concerned with FAST FOILS (NZ) actions when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

FLOW METER (E. Finnegan) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

#### RACE 7: RICHARD RAY INSURANCE BROKERS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1300 Metres

HARBOURING (D. Tourneur) - raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Shifted in near the 200 metres and bumped EUROGEM.

PAINT THIS CITY (B. Price) – rider reported the gelding failed to travel throughout, which was unusual and failed to respond to his riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer, Mr R. Gilchrist, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race start.

SUNNY GREEN (C. Lions) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

EUROGEM (K. Zechner) - shifted out near the 200 metres and bumped HARBOURING.

KILOWATT (A. Jordsjo) – blundered badly at the start and almost dislodged its rider. Approaching the 200 metres the gelding was disappointed for a run behind FENCELINE and to the inside of AMUSING MAGNUS. Rider explained she felt she was travelling well enough to ease AMUSING MAGNUS wider however, after committing to and failing to secure that run she became aware of a run to her inside and shifted in across the heels of FENCLINE and YOU ES MARSHAL. Rider conceded in hindsight, her best option would have been to take the inside run earlier. Stewards agreed with Ms Jordsjo's comments, however were of the opinion that given the circumstances it was reasonable for Ms Jordsjo to test the run to her outside and therefore no further action was taken.

## RACE 8: MED ELECTRICAL BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres

GOLIOTUS (L. Halliday) - became loose on entering the parade ring. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.



BRONSKI (E. Annells) – stumbled badly at the start, shifted out and bumped MOSCOW MULE. Near the 1100 metres was crowed for room on the inside of MOSCOW MULE and had to be checked.

## RACE 8: MED ELECTRICAL BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1400 Metres (Cont'd)

SADUKA (K. Crowther) - slow to begin.

O'MIZZNA (E. Finnegan) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course at the request of Trainer Ms S. Murphy and was found to have lacerations to its off side hip due to being fractious in the float. Stewards declared O'MIZZNA a late scratching at 3.05 pm on veterinary advice.

TOUGH LASSIE (S. Logan) - near the 1100 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of MOSCOW MULE, crowding that horse in onto BRONSKI resulting in BRONSKI being crowded for room and having to be checked. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under AR131(a) in that she shifted ground when insufficiently clear and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence at midnight on Saturday, 16 October and to conclude at midnight on Sunday, 24 October 2021: a period of four meetings.

MOSCOW MULE (A. Jordsjo) - bumped on jumping away by BRONSKI to its inside. Near the 1100 metres shifted in when crowded by TOUGH LASSIE to its outside.

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#### GENERAL:

Trainer vehicles and floats were inspected on arrival on course and no prohibited substances or equipment were found.
