Report on Race Meeting held at Kingscote Racecourse by the Kangaroo Island Racing Club on Thursday, 17 February 2022

RACE 1: PIRATE LIFE MAIDEN PLATE - 1050 Metres

COMEON SCRUFF (C. Lions) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the mare had not raced for nearly a year and was passed fit to start. Rounding the turn near the 800 metres the mare raced greenly and lost ground. Passing the 300 metres the mare lost its footing and fell, hampering HACKERESS and BAY OF ANGELS, which were following. C. Lions remained conscious; however, was transferred to hospital for observation. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities; however, medication was required.

HACKERESS (S. Logan) - hampered and lost ground near the 300 metres by COMEON SCRUFF, which lost its footing and fell.

PADSTOW POLLY (A. Jordsjo) - rider reported that the mare felt uncomfortable in its action rounding the home turn.

SAINT OLGA (A. Lindsay) - raced wide throughout the event.

BAY OF ANGELS (A. Chung) - hampered and lost ground near the 300 metres by COMEON SCRUFF, which lost its footing and fell.

RICH GINA (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly and lost ground. Hung in, in the straight.

TOUCH MY HEART (J. Doyle) - fractious in the barriers. Trainer, Mr C. Bieg was advised that a warning had been placed on the filly's barrier manners.

RACE 2: MILLIE MAE'S PANTRY MAIDEN HANDICAP - 1360 Metres

PATANDMICK (D. Caboche) - difficult to load. Co-trainers, Mr G. Searle was advised that a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its barrier manners. Raced wide throughout the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TABLE OF DREAMS (J. Potter) - shifted in and brush the rail near the 500 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZESTEND (E. Wong) - underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as the gelding had not raced for over a year and was passed fit to start.

GENERAL

Prior to the running of Race 2, the track was examined near the 300 metres by the Stewards and delegates representing the jockeys riding at the meeting and was deemed to be satisfactory to race on; however, it would be monitored for the remainder of the meeting.

The race times for the remainder of the meeting were amended as follows:

Race 2: 2:40 pm, Race 3: 3:15 pm, Race 4: 3:50 pm, Race 5: 4:25 pm, Race 6: 5:00 pm, Race 7: 5:20 pm.

After the running of Race 2 delegates representing the jockeys riding at the meeting expressed further concerns with the track, in particular shortly after passing the 800 metres.

Stewards, along with the delegates representing the jockeys, had a further more detailed examination of the area of concern.

Stewards and the delegates representing the jockeys were not satisfied with the condition of the track near the 750 metres.

After exhausting options to rectify or by-pass the section of concern Stewards postponed the remainder of the meeting (Races 3 to 7) at 3:10 pm.
