

Racing SA Ltd Stipendiary Stewards' Report

Report on Race Meeting held at Port Lincoln
Racecourse by the Port Lincoln Racing Club on
Friday, 4 March 2022

RACE 1: AVIS PORT LINCOLN FOUR-YEARS-OLD & OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1210 Metres

AKUBRA BLACK (T. Pannell) - near the 400 metres was taken wider by SURVEY LANE onto NISKIE LATANIE.

ANGRY ANT (B. Price) - upon arrival on course underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had raced at Balaklava on Wednesday, 2 March 2022 and was passed fit to start.

LACHLAN CASTLE (S. Metcalfe) - on jumping away was hampered as LORAINE'S FLOWJO was taken out. Rider explained in relation to the gelding's performance that it had difficulty breathing during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed an abrasion to the near hind fetlock and multiple skin lacerations to the off hind pastern.

LORAINE'S FLOWJO (E. Wong) - on jumping away was hampered by NISKIE LATANIE and was taken out. Raced wide without cover throughout the event.

SURVEY LANE (S. Callow) - approaching the 400 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of TELEPORTATION and when being restrained rolled out onto AKUBRA BLACK, which was taken out. Hung in under pressure in the straight.

TWO BEERS (R. Hurdle) - rider reported that the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a small skin abrasion to its top hip and bleeding inside the corner of its mouth.

NISKIE LATANIE (A. Lindsay) - on jumping away was taken out by PROUD MARY onto LORAINE'S FLOWJO. Near the 400 metres was obliged to be checked when awkwardly placed on the heels of LORAINE'S FLOWJO as AKUBRA BLACK was taken wider.

PROUD MARY (A. Chung) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto NISKIE LATANIE. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

TELEPORTATION (C. Murray) - hung out rounding the home turn.

LADY VENUS (NZ) (S. Logan) - jumped away awkwardly and was slow to begin.



RACE 2: BOSTON BAY GREAT WHITE THREE-YEAR-OLD BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

BOOLCUNDA KING (D. Tourneur) - inside the 400 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of PRETENTIOUS DIVA, which commenced to weaken and was awkward in its action. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

DAY FOR IT (NZ) (A. Chung) - inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

ORIEDOS (B. Price) - proved unruly behind the barriers. Trainer, Mr B. Cozamanis, was advised a warning had been placed on the gelding in relation to its pre-race behaviour.

KURIMUZON (T. Voorham) - resaddled on arrival at the barriers.

TUFF OPERATOR (C. Murray) - on jumping away lost its position when tightened onto BOOLCUNDA KING as VON GEORGE shifted out.

VON GEORGE (D. Caboche) - on jumping away was tightened onto TUFF OPERATOR by MEGAPHONE, which shifted out.

SECOND LAST CHANCE (A. Jordsjo) - proved unruly behind the barriers. Trainer, Mr T. Haddy, was advised a warning had been placed on the filly in relation to its pre-race behaviour. Jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin. Rider reported that the filly raced greenly throughout the event. Trainer, Mr T. Haddy, was advised that a warning had been placed on the filly in relation to its pre-race behaviour.

GYPSY BLAZE (E. Wong) - hung in under pressure in the straight.

PRETENTIOUS DIVA (E. Boyd) - became awkward in its action inside the 400 metres and commenced to weaken. At the entrance to the straight rolled in slightly onto MEGAPHONE. Rider reported that the filly changed stride on a number of occasions during the event and was untractable when placed under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MEGAPHONE (S. Metcalfe) - jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto VON GEORGE. At the entrance to the straight was obliged to be steadied as PRETENTIOUS DIVA rolled in.

RACE 3: MCDONALD'S PORT LINCOLN FLYING HANDICAP - 1210 Metres

MIDNIGHT BRAWLER (NZ) (S. Callow) - on jumping away bumped CENTREFIELD, which rolled in.


CENTREFIELD (B. Price) - proved unruly behind the barriers. Trainer, Mr R King, was advised a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its pre-race behaviour. On jumping away, shifted in and bumped MIDNIGHT BRAWLER (NZ).

ARTFUL AMBITION (A. Jordsjo) - jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Hung out throughout the event.

TANJA'S DREAM (D. Tourneur) - rider report that the mare did not feel comfortable in its action when placed under pressure over the concluding stages of the event and therefore he elected not to ride the mare out in his normal manner. A post-race veterinary examination revealed multiple skin lacerations to the off hind pastern.

KINGSON (D. Caboche) - rider reported that the gelding did not feel comfortable in its action during the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed multiple skin lacerations to the off hind pastern.

RACE 4: OPEN EYRE EVENTS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres



ROCK HARD (E. Wong) - rounding the home turn brushed WAR CHEVAL. Hung in under pressure in the straight.

WAR CHEVAL (S. Logan) - rounding the home turn rolled out and brushed ROCK HARD.



RACE 4: OPEN EYRE EVENTS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1000 Metres (cont'd)

CALL ME HERBIE (D. Caboche) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

I GOT STRINGS (R. Hurdle) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

LULU DESIGN (K. Crowther) - had difficulty obtaining clear running from shortly after the entrance to the straight until near the 200 metres. Held up from the 200 metres until approaching the 100 metres. Inside the 100 metres raced in restricted room between BEERMINT and SECRET CHARGE and was obliged to shift to the outside of SECRET CHARGE as that gelding rolled in slightly. Near the 100 metres the mare was struck over the nostril by the whip of A. Lindsay (BEERMINT).

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow rider, K. Crowther (LULU DESIGN), placed second, and Trainer, Mr S. Cahill, to view the vision in the straight.

RACE 5: COMPLETE BUSINESS & ACCOUNTING SERVICES FOUR-YEAR-OLD & UP BENCHMARK 58 HANDICAP - 1250 Metres

JONQUEST (B. Price) - on jumping away bumped CHARGING FIRE which shifted in and was taken in and bumped HIGHLY RIGHTEOUS. When questioned in relation to his tactics adopted in today's event and the gelding's performance, rider explained that he jumped better than he expected and therefore found himself caught wide and as a result he elected to settle further forward rather than restrain his mount and continue to race wide. He added that in his opinion the gelding may not have handled its top weight of 63.0 kg.

TRENCH WARFARE (NZ) (E. Wong) - on jumping away was hampered when taken in by ISA SECRET. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RIVERSIDE ROCK (S. Callow) - rider reported that the gelding hung out throughout the event.

MR WHITACRE (R. Hurdle) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

CHARGING FIRE (K. Crowther) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped JONQUEST.

HIGHLY RIGHTEOUS (A. Jordsjo) - on jumping away bumped JONQUEST and ISA SECRET.

ISA SECRET (E. Boyd) - over raced in the middle stages of the event when being restrained. Inclined to hang out from rounding the home turn and under pressure in the straight.

HURRICANE SONNY (S. Logan) - held up for clear running rounding the home turn.

RACE 6: THE MAX GLENN, VOICE OF THE WEST BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1750 Metres


DIAMONDS ARE (R. Hurdle) - slow to begin. When questioned in relation to the gelding's disappointing performance, rider explained that it travelled well in the early and middle stages of the event; however, when asked to improve from near the 800 metres, the gelding dipped and he became concerned with its action after putting it under more pressure shortly after. He added that after rounding the home turn he elected not to ride the gelding out in his normal manner due to the concerns he had in relation to the gelding's action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

A KNIGHT IN PARIS (D. Tourneur) - inside the 400 metres became awkwardly placed on the heels of CHARLTON, was obliged to be checked and shifted out abruptly. Rider reported the gelding made the home turn awkwardly.

MISTA KNOWITALL (A. Chung) - near the 400 metres improved onto the heels of BONIFACE (NZ), which had commenced to weaken and appeared to clip the heels of BONIFACE (NZ) and lost ground. Held up rounding the home turn. Rider was reminded of his obligations under AR131(b) to ensure he rides his mounts out fully to the finish.

VANCOUVER VELVET (E. Wong) - laid in under pressure in the straight.





RACE 7: MGA INSURANCE GROUP 2022 PORT LINCOLN CUP - 1960 Metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately four minutes owing to FEARLESS AL.

GRINZINGER STAR (NZ) (S. Callow) - laid out under pressure in the straight.

WITCH KID (T. Voorham) - in the inside barrier to FEARLESS AL, which was fractious, became cast and kicked out and underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to start.

PAULO PACE (A. Jordsjo) - inside the 400 metres raced in restricted room and was obliged to be steadied.

FEARLESS AL (B. Price) - fractious in the barrier, reared over and became cast. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was ruled unfit to start. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew FEARLESS AL at 4.32 pm. Co-trainer, Mr J. Dunn, was advised that the gelding was now required to prove tractable in an Official Barrier Trial prior to a future race start.

ONEMORE MARSHALL (E.Boyd) - in the outside barrier to FEARLESS AL, which was fractious, became cast and kicked out and underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and passed fit to start. Jumped away awkwardly. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. Held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until approaching the 200 metres and then commenced to lay in for the remainder of the event.

RACE 8: BENDIGO COMMUNITY BANK PORT LINCOLN BENCHMARK 62 HANDICAP - 1350 Metres

AMANI FARASI (A. Jordsjo) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and contacted SIRMAZE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CROWNED KING (A. Chung) - near the 200 metres was momentarily inconvenienced as JUSTICA rolled out. Inside the 100 metres when laying in became awkwardly placed on the heels of BELLOWS for a short distance. Approaching the finish raced in restricted room between bellows and JUSTICA.

SORRIDERE (E. Wong) - near the 700 metres appeared to jump a section of the track and was awkward in its stride resulting in the rider becoming unbalanced. Hung out under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed multiple skin lacerations to the off hind pastern.

TIME WARRIOR (R. Hurdle) - inclined to shift about under pressure in the straight.

SIRMAZE (C. Murray) - on jumping away contacted AMANI FARASI, which shifted out.

SWING IT SISTER (T. Voorham) - jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow into stride.

THE MASTER (D. Caboche) - held up for clear running from rounding the home turn until near the 100 metres when awkwardly placed between SORRIDERE and RED DYNAMO (NZ) and was obliged to shift out to obtain clear running.
