RACE 1: MURRAY PEST CONTROL - CLEVE / TUMBY TROUGHS BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP - 1000 metres

LUDUS MAGNUS (D. Caboche) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have cardiac arrhythmia. Trainer, Mr S. Drewitt, was advised the results of an ECG are to be forwarded to the TRSA Veterinary Surgeon and a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness would be required prior to the gelding performing satisfactorily in an Official Barrier Trial.

INNOVATE (NZ) (J. Huxtable) – raced in restricted room from rounding the home turn until in the vicinity of the 200 metres.

RACE 2: BILL HITCHCOCK MEMORIAL / WEST END / LOCK HOTEL / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE – 1200 metres

HARDAZ (J. Huxtable) - late scratching due to transport difficulties at 10.00 am.

AHECKSTAR (W. Kerford) – rider reported the filly blundered in the vicinity of the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ARTFUL IGGY (B. Griffiths) – laid in under pressure over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: LOCK AG SERVICES BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

TRIUMPHANT ONE (B. Griffiths) – severely hampered in the vicinity of the 1000 metres when obliged to be checked to avoid the heels of SOUND OF VICTORY, which was taken in by GEORDIE'S SECOND, which was taken in by BOLD SENATOR, which shifted in when insufficiently clear.

KINGDOM OF WAR (L. Stojakovic) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced in over twelve months and found to be lame near foreleg. Stewards withdrew KINGDOM OF WAR at 1.33 pm. Trainer, Mr M. Moosha, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

RACE 3: LOCK AG SERVICES BENCHMARK 72 HANDICAP - 1200 metres (cont'd)

GEORDIE'S SECOND (D. Tootell) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres crowded by BOLD SENATOR, which shifted in when insufficiently clear.

SOUND OF VICTORY (T. Zanker) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres was obliged to be checked to avoid the heels of GEORDIE'S SECOND, which was taken in by BOLD SENATOR, which was shifted in when insufficiently clear.

BOLD SENATOR (V. Wong) – in the vicinity of the 1000 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of GEORDIE'S SECOND, which was taken in onto SOUND OF VICTORY, which was obliged to be checked and as a result was taken in onto TRIUMPHANT ONE, which was severely hampered and obliged to be checked. Rider charged under AR137(a) for careless riding. Inquiry adjourned to a date to be fixed to allow Mr R. Jolly, master of apprentice V. Wong, to be present.

TWISTED MILLER (C. Davies) – struck a perimeter fence en route to the barriers. Underwent a prerace veterinary examination and passed fit to start. Slow into stride.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow B. Griffiths (TRIUMPHANT ONE) placed sixth, to view the vision from in the vicinity of the 1000 metres.

RACE 4: THE GRAIN TEAM PTY LTD BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1400 metres

FINNISS MOMENT (J. Huxtable) – rider reported the mare resented the kick back and was reluctant to improve behind runners. Laid in under pressure over the concluding stages.

VALIK (V. Wong) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out brushing READY AGAIN.

CARDINAL MISSION (B. Griffiths) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

HERE COMES THEBOOM (E. Boyd) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted in brushing READY AGAIN.

READY AGAIN (D. Tootell) – hampered on jumping away when HERE COMES THEBOOM shifted in and VALIK shifted out, and as a result lost its position. Rider reported the gelding blundered on a number of occasions in the vicinity of the 400 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

TICKET TO PARIS (D. Caboche) – hung out rounding the home turn.

RACE 5: RAMSEY BROS 51ST LOCK CUP - 1900 metres

DEVON (B. Griffiths) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

VALUE AS (E. Boyd) – in the vicinity of the 1400 metres raced keenly onto the heels of MONTALTO and had to be restrained.

RACE 6: LOCK FRIENDLY GROCER / FROSTINGS & SPRINKLES CAFE BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP – 1800 metres

CASIRAGHI (B. Griffiths) – rider lost his near side iron in the vicinity of the 400 metres placing him at a disadvantage for the remained of the event.

SUMITEE (L. Stojakovic) – rider reported that in her opinion the mare resented the kick back and was reluctant to improve behind runners.

RACE 6: LOCK FRIENDLY GROCER / FROSTINGS & SPRINKLES CAFE BENCHMARK 54 HANDICAP – 1800 metres (cont'd)

ROMULUS FLIGHT (T. Pannell) – required to be re-saddled on arrival at the barriers.
