THOROUGHBRED RACING S.A. LIMITED STIPENDIARY STEWARDS' REPORT

Report on Race Meeting held at Strathalbyn Racecourse by the Strathalbyn Racing Club on Sunday, 8 October 2017

RAIL: Rail out 2 metres from 1600 metres to 1400 metres, true remainder.

RACE 1: THE HIVE / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 metres

BON AIRE (J. Toeroek) – shifted in on jumping away making contact with ZAVILLA. Raced keenly in the middle stages of the event.

ASHADY HUSSY (J. Bowditch) – laid in under pressure in the straight and in the vicinity of the 50 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of JACK'S SISTER, which had to be taken hold of. Rider severely reprimanded.

DELLACQUA (K. Crowther) – shifted out passing the winning post, dislodging its rider. K. Crowther was examined by the First Care Medical staff and was passed fit to fulfil her remaining engagements. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

JACK'S SISTER (V. Wong) – held up for clear running in the vicinity of the 400 metres. In the vicinity of the 50 metres had to be checked to avoid the heels of ASHADY HUSSY, which shifted in, and ZAVILLA, which shifted out.

OUR MEMORIES (J. Holder) – trainer, Mr J. Macmillan, was advised that a warning had been placed on the filly in relation to its barrier manners. Bound on jumping away and was slow as a result.

ZAVILLA (R. Hurdle) – shifted out making contact with BON AIRE on jumping away. In the vicinity of the 50 metres shifted out under pressure when insufficiently clear of JACK'S SISTER. Rider severely reprimanded.

RACE 2: HILLS PARTYJUKE / SABOIS FOUR-YEAR-OLD AND OVER MAIDEN PLATE - 1350 metres

KRUPT LEDA (V. Wong) – over-raced in the middles stages of the event. Held up for clear running from the entrance to the home straight to inside the 300 metres.

PERSEVERANCE (J. Bowditch) – when questioned regarding the performance of the gelding rider reported that PERSEVERANCE hung in severely throughout the event and in the vicinity of the 150 metres had his near side rein dislodged by R. Clark's whip. He added that he was able to regather his rein shortly after but due to his mount's manners he was unable to fully test the gelding over concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 3: TOFFISH / SABOIS MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

CRUISING (J. Holder) – late scratching at 2.15 pm on veterinary advice after being fractious in the barriers.

IT'S OUR LIFE (R. Hurdle) - began awkwardly, shifted out and made contact with ROSE DELIGHT.

IT'S A FIREBALL (J. Toeroek) – began awkwardly, shifted in and made contact with ROSE DELIGHT.

ROSE DELIGHT (D. Tourneur) – hampered on jumping away. In the vicinity of the 500 metres became awkward after racing in restricted room between BRONETONE and ASPALIS.

CHAMPERS ON ICE (K. Crowther) – late scratching at 2.15 pm on veterinary advice. Trainer, Mr D. Jolly, was advised that CHAMPERS ON ICE would be required to trial to the Stewards' satisfaction prior to a future race.

RACE 4: DAISH IRRIGATION BM 60 HANDICAP - 1350 metres

SIR CHARLESTON (NZ) (A. Doyle) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

WICKED RHYTHM (S. Fawke) – held up for clear running on entering the straight. Had to be restrained approaching the winning post after INNESTON shifted out when insufficiently clear.

HIDDEN FORTUNE (V. Wong) – laid in rounding the home turn and entering the straight. Laid out when placed under pressure over the concluding stages of the event taking IMPORTANT wider on the track. Rider reminded of his obligations to stop riding and straighten his mounts when the shift ground.

IMPORTANT (K. Crowther) – taken wider on the track in the straight by HIDDEN FORTUNE, which shifted out.

INNESTON (Jemma Frew) – rider reported her mount hung out throughout the event. Laid out under pressure over the concluding stages, shifted out when insufficiently clear of WICKED RHYTHM. Rider reprimanded.

SVETSKI (J. Huxtable) – rider reported that his mount began to weaken from the vicinity of the 700 metres, became awkward in its stride in the straight and for this reason he elected not to place his mount under pressure over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities. Trainer, Mrs S. Nolan, was advised that SVETSKI would be required to perform to the Stewards satisfaction in an Official Barrier Trial prior to a future race.

RORY'S UNION – late scratching at 11.27 am as there was no apprentice rider available.

Correct weight was delayed to allow Mr J. Macmillan, the trainer of IMPORTANT, to view the Official Vision in the straight.

RACE 5: MCILROY AUTO GROUP BM 60 HANDICAP - 2050 metres

TIME ROGUE (J. Toeroek) – when questioned regarding the performance of the gelding rider reported that TIME ROGUE began to weaken from the vicinity of the 1200 metres and ran to the line in a disappointing manner. He further added that in his opinion TIME ROGUE may not have handled the quick back up from its last run on 2 October 207 at Gawler. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PRESUMPTION (J. Kah) – trainer, Mr S. Theodore, advised Stewards prior to the event that he would instruct J. Kah to attempt to settle off pace with cover if possible which was a change from its most recent start. Settled forward of midfield with cover. Held up for clear running rounding the home turn.

FANTASTIC MAGIC (C. Lindop) – over-raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

EXALTED DEE (D. Tourneur) – laid in when placed under pressure in the straight.

RACE 5: MCILROY AUTO GROUP BM 60 HANDICAP - 2050 metres (cont'd)

CIVETTA (K. Bishop) – had to be restrained shortly after jumping away after becoming awkward on the heels of PRESUMPTION.

JARRVIS (J. Huxtable) - raced wide without cover throughout the event.

Following the running of this event Jemma Frew stood herself down from her remaining rides on medical grounds. She was advised that she would be required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding again.

RACE 6: HIGH STREET TRADING BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1600 metres

DANCES ON STARS (NZ) (A. Doyle) – raced wide without cover throughout the event.

ZOLOTOI (J. Huxtable) – in the vicinity of the 1500 metres had to be restrained to avoid the heels of ITCHYZARIZ, which was taken in by ZERO PATIENCE, which shifted in when insufficiently clear. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ITCHYZARIZ (J. Potter) – in the vicinity of the 1500 metres was taken in onto ZOLOTOI by ZERO PATIENCE, which shifted in when insufficiently clear. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ZERO PATIENCE (J. Bowditch) – in the vicinity of the 1500 metres shifted in when insufficiently clear of ITCHYZARIZ, which was taken in onto ZOLOTOI, which had to be restrained to avoid the heels of ITCHYZARIZ. Rider found guilty of a charge of careless riding under AR137(a) and was suspended from riding in races for a period to commence midnight Saturday, 14 October 2017 and to conclude midnight Friday, 20 October 2017 – a period of three meetings. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 7: LANGHORNE CREEK WINE REGION BENCHMARK 56 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

MASTER BLACK (K. Crowther) – hampered shortly after jumping away when WISE AND HAPPY rolled out.

WISE AND HAPPY (J. Huxtable) – rolled out shortly after jumping away and hampered MASTER BLACK.

ALL BAR TWO (R. Clarke) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it had not raced in ten months and was passed fit to start.

ESPRESSO LASS (J. Bowditch) – awkward to begin.

SAMBUCA SIREN (K. Stra) – slow to begin.
