Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse by the Gawler & Barossa Jockey Club on Sunday, 29 July 2018

RACE 1: AUSBIA ELECTRICAL HURDLE – 3340 metres

TUNES (R. David) – jumped the ninth hurdle awkwardly. Jumped the tenth hurdle awkwardly.

SEARAVEN (M. Kelly) – underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival on course and was passed fit to start.

THE BIG CHEESE (J. Matthews) – jumped the first hurdle awkwardly. Jumped the seventh hurdle awkwardly. Eased out of the event from in the vicinity of the 700 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding had bled from both nostrils. Trainer, Ms C. Rose, was advised that as this was the gelding's first bi-lateral bleed THE BIG CHEESE was now suspended from racing for a period of three months in accordance with AR53A and would be required to gallop 1000 metres in the presence of a Steward prior to accepting for a future race.

CONSTANT RETURN (J. Lynch) – permission was granted for J. Lynch to ride the mare 1.5 kilograms over its declared weight. Jumped the second hurdle awkwardly. Unbalanced on landing after jumping the final hurdle.

All runners underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no further visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: BAROSSA VOLKSWAGEN / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1200 metres

EASY TIGER (R. Hurdle) – in the vicinity of the 700 metres rolled in marginally and contacted SASSY RAIDER.

EXALTED TRAIL (T. Pannell) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and contacted LUNCH MONEY, which was hampered. Raced greenly in the straight and was inclined to lay in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ADOZENROSES (K. Crowther) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out contacting LUNCH MONEY, which was hampered. Inclined to lay out from inside the 200 metres.

ISLAND GAME (J. Holder) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 2: BAROSSA VOLKSWAGEN / SABOIS TWO-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE – 1200 metres (cont'd)

LUNCH MONEY (P. Gatt) – hampered on jumping away as EXALTED TRAIL jumped away awkwardly and shifted in and ADOZENROSES jumped away awkwardly and shifted out. **SASSY RAIDER** (D. Tourneur) – jumped away awkwardly. In the vicinity of the 700 metres contacted with EASY TIGER, which rolled in marginally.

RACE 3: COOPERS SESSION ALE MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 metres

DOUBLE BURNER (R. Clark) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EURO GOLD (D. Tourneur) – trainer, Mr G. Young, was fined \$100 under AR59A for failing to produce the Thoroughbred Identification Card. EURO GOLD was permitted to start as it was able to be identified from records held by Stewards. Rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and reprimanded.

MANILOW (P. Gatt) – prior to the running of this event co-trainer, Mr C. Binnie, advised Stewards that he would instruct rider P. Gatt to attempt to settle the gelding more forward in today's event given the gelding had drawn the inside barrier. Settled mid-field.

BRAKEFOOT BLING (J. Huxtable) – proved difficult to load. Trainer, Mr C. Reardon, was advised a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its barrier manners. Raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

IT'S PRIMROSE (A. Lindsay) – performed poorly. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EUREKA SKY (K. Crowther) – hung out rounding the home turn.

RACE 4: TERRACE FUNCTION CENTRE MAIDEN PLATE - 1700 metres

CHARLIELOVEIT (K. Bishop) – in the vicinity of the 1400 metres when racing keenly was obliged to be restrained when awkwardly placed on the heels of SAZANDA. From thereafter shifted out and raced wide without cover for the remainder of the event.

FEAR NO FOE (J. Maund) – slow to begin.

SHIRLEY'S EAGLE (A. Chan) – inclined to lay out under pressure in the straight.

LOWS AND HIGHS (D. Tourneur) – held up for clear running for a number of strides at the entrance to the straight when racing between AHECKSTAR and SAZANDA.

NIMIR (E. Finnegan) – rider reported the gelding was inclined to hang out from in the vicinity of the 600 metres.

RACE 5: SANDERS FODDER / MITAVITE / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes.

FUTAGO (K. Bishop) – shortly after jumping away was contacted by CARIBBEAN COUP, which jumped away awkwardly and shifted in.

OUR JOURNEYMAN (J. Huxtable) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted in and bumped PANZER PRINCESS.

WOKIT (R. Sakai) – required to be re-shod prior to exiting the mounting yard as it had dislodged its near hind show. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination on arrival at the barriers and was passed fit to start. Raced greenly in the straight and from in the vicinity of the 100 metres was inclined to hang out taking CARIBBEAN COUP wider.

RACE 5: SANDERS FODDER / MITAVITE / SABOIS THREE-YEAR-OLD MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres (cont'd)

AMBISHOP (E. Finnegan) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

CARIBBEAN COUP (A. Chan) – jumped away awkwardly and shortly after shifted in abruptly contacting FUTAGO and as a result became awkward in its action for a number of strides. Taken wider from in the vicinity of the 100 metres by WOKIT, which hung out. Rider explained that it was his instructions and intention to settle outside the lead; however, given the manner in which the filly began he was obliged to settle further back. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PANZER PRINCESS (R. Clark) – jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped OUR JOURNEYMAN.

RACE 6: RON HUGHES MEMORIAL CUP / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

The start of this event was delayed approximately two minutes owing to the rider change for BOLDACIOUS GIRL.

MASIPAG (A. Lindsay) – inclined to lay in under pressure in the straight.

MUSICAL QUERY (J. Huxtable) – taken in on jumping away by PARTY SET, which jumped away awkwardly and shifted in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

PARTY SET (K. Bishop) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted in taking MUSICAL QUERY in. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

BOLDACIOUS GIRL (K. Crowther) – slow to begin.

RACE 7: GOLDIN FARMS - AKEED MOFEED CLASS TWO HANDICAP - 1500 metres

ANCIENT HISTORY (IRE) (E. Finnegan) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

EXTREME WITNESS (A. Chan) – inside the 1300 metres got its head up and raced ungenerously for a short distance.

EXALTED HONEY (J. Holder) – slow to begin. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

GARGAMEL (D. Tourneur) – rider pleaded guilty to a charge under AR137A(5)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on more than five occasions prior to the 100 metres and was reprimanded.

PEARL RAIDER (R. Clark) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SELDOM HOME (D. McWhinney) – slow to begin.

RACE 8: SOMERSET HOTEL SOCIAL CLUB BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1200 metres

SNOWBROOK (K. Crowther) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event.

EXALTED LAURETTA (T. Pannell) – in the vicinity of the 800 metres shifted in onto COPERNICUS, which was obliged to be eased. Rider reprimanded under AR137(a) and advised to take greater care in future.

SILENT ICE (R. Hurdle) – held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until approaching the 200 metres when it became disappointed for a run between LICORICE BULLET and VILLE DE BERNE and was obliged to be steadied and shift in to obtain clear running.

TOO TUFF TARA (R. Clark) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 8: SOMERSET HOTEL SOCIAL CLUB BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - 1200 metres (cont'd)

SAND CAT (D. Tourneur) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped LICORICE BULLET.

COPERNICUS (A. Jordsjo) – in the vicinity of the 800 metres was obliged to be eased as EXALTED LAURETTA shifted in.

GALCRUM (J. Maund) – jumped away awkwardly and as a result was slow to begin.

LICORICE BULLET (J. Holder) – on jumping away bumped with SAND CAT, which jumped away awkwardly and shifted out.

PURRFECT KISSES (K. Lau) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted in and shortly after was obliged to be restrained when awkwardly placed on the heels of MORCHOWIE MISS. Hung in under pressure in the straight.

GENERAL:

RACE 6: RON HUGHES MEMORIAL CUP / SABOIS FILLIES & MARES BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP - 1100 metres

R. Clarke pleaded guilty to a charge under AR175(k) in that she was negligent in weighing out without a surcingle which could have led to a breach of the Rules and was reprimanded.
