Report on Race Meeting held at Gawler Racecourse by the Gawler and Barossa Jockey Club on Saturday, 5 January 2019

RACE 1: GOLDIN FARMS - AKEED MOFEED HANDICAP - 1100 metres

OUTLANDOS (J. Kah) - laid in under pressure in the straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

ECLAIR BREEZE (T. Pannell) - jumped away awkwardly. Hung out rounding the home turn.

RACE 2: BAROSSA WINES AT THE RACES - SAT JAN 12TH HANDICAP - 1200 metres

MISS CUOCO (K. Crowther) - held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 500 metres until in the vicinity of the 400 metres.

QUIVERS (J. Holder) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

YANKEE EYES (J. Kah) - knuckled shortly after the start unbalancing its rider for a number of strides and as a result lost ground. Laid in under pressure in the straight proving difficult to ride out. Lost its near fore plate during the running of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a minor laceration to the near foreleg.

ARCTIC BLAZE (C. Caserta) - reared and fell backwards in the mounting yard. Underwent a prerace veterinary examination and ruled unfit to start. Acting on this advice Stewards withdrew ARCTIC BLAZE at 2.59 pm. Trainer, Mr D. Magro, was advised that a warning had been placed on the mare in relation to its pre-race behaviour. Mr Magro was also advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

RACE 3: COOPERS HANDICAP - 1700 metres

HUSSYBAY (C. Caserta) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

STRATEGIC DEMAND (K. Crowther) - hung in under pressure in the straight.

SAVATAG (NZ) (J. Kah) – raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the event. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

RACE 4: KINGSFORD HOTEL HANDICAP - 1500 metres

CANFORD (J. Kah) - inside the 200 metres brushed EQUIDAME, which shifted out. Performed below expectations. Rider reported that the gelding travelled well up until in the vicinity of the 1100 metres where it dropped the bridle and from that point on did not travel in the event and in her opinion raced flat and was disappointing in its efforts to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a lower than expected heart and respiratory rates.

MARINA (S. Fawke) - in the vicinity of the 500 metres rolled in onto WILLOCHRA, which was momentarily inconvenienced.

WILLOCHRA (D. Tourneur) - in the vicinity of the 500 metres was momentarily unconvinced as MARINA rolled in. Rider reported the mare dipped approaching the 50 metres. Rider explained that in his opinion the mare did not handle the back up from its run on Saturday, 29 December at Morphettville. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SUPERVELOCE (NZ) (K. Crowther) - held up for clear running from in the vicinity of the 400 metres until approaching the 100 metres.

EQUIDAME (C. Caserta) - slow to begin. Inside the 200 metres shifted out and brushed CANFORD.

RACE 5: TERRACE FUNCTION CENTRE MAIDEN PLATE - 1100 metres

EXALTED TRAIL (J. Potter) - at the entrance to the straight shifted out and bumped LA VITA, which was taken wider.

RAISE A SHOW (J. Toeroek) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the colt to be lame in the off foreleg. First aid administered. Trainer, Mr G. Young, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to future trial or race.

CHARMIST (J. Holder) - on jumping away bumped with ABBI FEDE, which was taken out when inconvenienced and contacted by NORMAN PRINCESS.

LA VITA (A. Jordsjo) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. At the entrance to the straight bumped with EXALTED TRAIL, which shifted out and was taken wider.

LEONARDA (K. Bishop) - over-raced in the early stages of the event.

NORMAN PRINCESS (T. Pannell) - contacted on jumping away as CHARMIST was taken out.

SHINING BRIGHTLY (A. Chan) - jumped away awkwardly. Approaching the 200 metres was obliged to be steadied momentarily when attempting a tight run to the inside of SOPHINA DIVA.

ABBI FEDE (S. Fawke) - jumped away awkwardly, shifted out and bumped CHARMIST. At the entrance to the straight was held up for a short distance. Momentarily held up for a short distance at the entrance to the straight.

RACE 6: AUSBIA ELECTRICAL HANDICAP - 1100 metres

AADELAD (R. Clark) - jumped away awkwardly.

OVER AND ABOVE (C. Caserta) - in the vicinity of the 50 metres commenced to lay in at the same time as DOMINATION, which was weakening, rolled out. As a result OVER AND ABOVE became awkwardly placed on the heels of DOMINATION, became severely unbalanced and shifted in abruptly onto STREET LIFE.

STREET LIFE (T. Pannell) - in the vicinity of the 50 metres was obliged to be steadied and lost its position as OVER AND ABOVE shifted in abruptly. As a result STREET LIFE was untested to the line.

ALASKAN JADE (J. Holder) - hung in under pressure in the straight. In the vicinity of the 30 metres shifted onto DOMINATION, which rolled out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

DOMINATION (J. Kah) - commenced to lay out from in the vicinity of the 200 metres. Rolled out in the vicinity of the 50 metres onto OVER AND ABOVE.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow T. Pannell (STREET LIFE) placed fourth, to view the vision in the straight.

Correct weight for this event was further delayed to allow J. Holder (ALASKAN JADE) placed third, and trainer, Mr D. Magro, to view the vision in the straight. After doing so J. Holder lodged an objection against DOMINATION (J. Kah) being declared the second placegetter on the grounds of alleged interference over the concluding 150 metres. After considering the evidence, viewing the vision and acting on their own observations Stewards dismissed the objection.

RACE 7: SANDERS FODDER HANDICAP - 2100 metres

SOARING HIGH (R. Clark) – a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off foreleg. Co-trainers, Mr L. Macdonald and Mr A. Gluyas, were advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

EXALTED CRAFTSMAN (S. Cahill) - on jumping away was taken out by SET TO CRUISE and contacted MARMAN.

DOUBLE YOU TEE (K. Crowther) - rider explained that the gelding travelled well during the event; however, in the vicinity of the 600 metres when asked for an effort failed to respond to her riding and was disappointing to the finish. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

SET TO CRUISE (T. Pannell) – jumped away awkwardly and shifted out onto EXALTED CRAFTSMAN, which was taken out. In the vicinity of the 400 metres raced in restricted room for a short distance between SOARING HIGH and EXALTED CRAFTSMAN. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no visible abnormalities.

MARMAN (C. Caserta) - on jumping away contacted with EXALTED CRAFTSMAN, which was taken out.

EPERDUMENT (J. Potter) – at the entrance to the straight was disappointed when attempting a tight run between EXALTED CRAFTSMAN and DOUBLE YOU TEE. Thereafter was held up for clear running until in the vicinity of the 150 metres.

LAST ONE NAMED (A. Chan) - held up for clear running from the entrance to the straight until the 100 metres when racing between SOARING HIGH and SET TO CRUISE.

RACE 8: HOLDFAST INSURANCE HANDICAP - 1200 metres

COCKLES (C. Caserta) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg. Trainer, Ms R. Anderson, was advised a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

COUNTER SPIN (R. Clark) - slow into stride.

VALLIANO (D. Caboche) - had difficulty obtaining clear ground from in the vicinity of the 600 metres until the entrance to the straight.

PRETIOSA (A. Chan) - a post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind leg. Trainer, Mr K. Sweeney, was advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

TURF TAPPER (K. Bishop) - became fractious in its barrier stall after being load. Underwent a prerace veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. Bumped with GOUGERS on jumping away.

TWO ODD SOX (J. Holder) - at the entrance to the straight raced in restricted room momentarily between GOUGERS and TRIPLE DEEZ.

ZAGATO STAR (D. Tourneur) – held up from the vicinity of the 400 metres until the entrance to the straight where it attempted a tight run to the inside of TURF TAPPER, which was weakening and rolled in. As a result TURF TAPPER's hindquarters were turned out.

OUR BENEVENTO (J. Toeroek) - raced wide without cover throughout the event. Laid in under pressure in the straight.

ENOUGH SWAGGER (J. Kah) – rider reported that the filly did not feel comfortable in its action over the concluding stages of the event and put an awkward stride in, in the vicinity of the 100 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the filly to be lame in the off hind leg. First aid administered. Co-trainers, Mr D. Clarken and Ms J. MacGillvray, were advised that a Veterinary Certificate of Fitness was required prior to a future trial or race.

GOUGERS (A. Jordsjo) - bumped with COUNTER SPIN on jumping away. Laid in under pressure in the vicinity of the 150 metres and thereafter shifted out for the remainder of the event.

Correct weight for this event was delayed to allow J. Holder (TWO ODD SOX), placed second, to view the vision in the straight.
